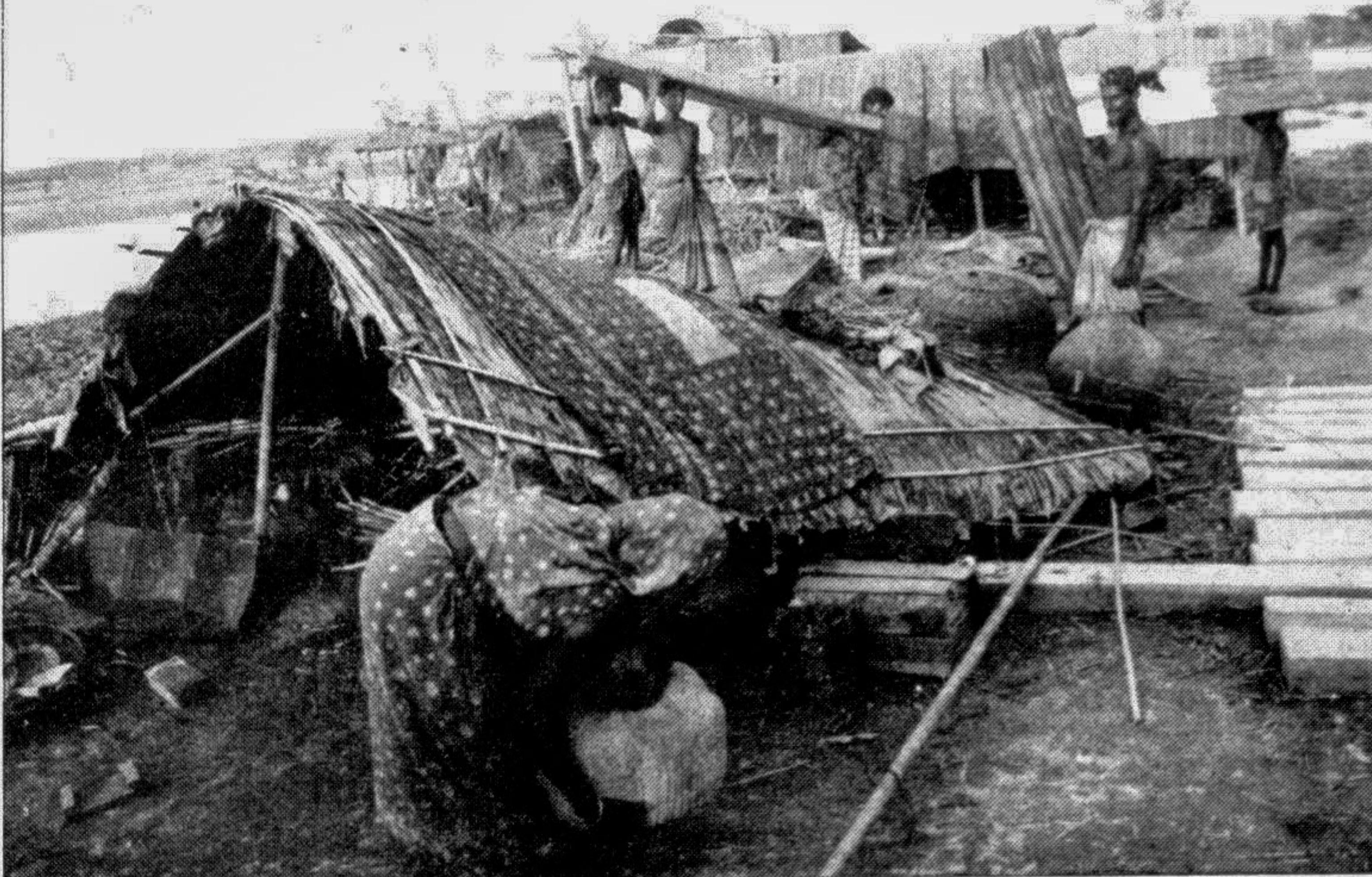
Husband kills wife in Sirajganj
