

Call to make 5th NID a success

Health and Family Welfare Minister Salahuddin Yusuf yesterday called upon the people of all strata to come forward in making the fifth National Immunisation Day (NID) on December 14, 1998 and February 2, 1999 a success, reports BSS.

Speaking as the chief guest at the national advocacy meeting on the day held at the EPI headquarters, the health minister said the objective of the National Immunisation Day is to prevent spread of polio all over the country by giving polio vaccines to all children under five in a single day.

He said the objectives of the Extended Programme for Immunisation (EPI) is to eradicate polio from the country by the year 2000 and its success would ensure health and bright future of a child.

Presided over by Health and Family Welfare Secretary M M Reza, the meeting was also addressed among others, by director general of health services Prof A K M Nurul Anwar, Director General of Family Planning Sirajul Islam and representatives of different donor agencies and countries.

The minister thanked the representatives of different government and non-government organisations, international institutions, donor countries and agencies for supporting the EPI. He specially thanked the government of Japan for its contribution.

He put emphasis on mass publicity through radio, television and newspapers to make the fifth NID a success.

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European parliamentary team praises water sharing accord

The visiting European parliamentary delegation has appreciated the signing of the water sharing agreement with India and the CHT peace accord, reports UNB.

The delegation was all praise for Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina for her initiative in initiating the two accords when it called on her at Ganobhaban in the city yesterday.

Officials said Anita Jean Pollack, the leader of the delegation, praised the prime minister for solving the Chittagong Hill Tracts problem by signing the peace accord and for signing the Ganges water sharing treaty with India.

Referring to the floods, the prime minister said although a large number of deaths in the flood was apprehended, little over a thousand people died due to flood-related reasons.

Hasina thanked the international community for their timely response to the call for helping Bangladesh during and after the flood.

She also spoke about the government's plan to contain flood, including river dredging and surface water management.

The delegation included Robert Evans, Le Ranhiel, Jose Javier Pomes Ruiz and Jan Wiebenga.

Foreign secretary Mustafizur Rahman and Parliament Affairs Secretary Quazi Manzur-e-Mowla were present.

The prime minister said the Chittagong Hill Tracts problem was solved through peaceful negotiation after 23 years. The longstanding problem was solved without the help of any third party, she added.

She said the government has started economic development of the area through short, medium and long term programmes.
