**\$3m Swiss grant for arsenic control projects**  
Switzerland will provide Bangladesh a grant of US dollar 3 million (Tk 14.40 crore) for co-financing the "Arsenic Mitigation-Water Supply Project" along with the World Bank, reports UNB.

An agreement to this effect was signed between Bangladesh and Switzerland yesterday.

Joint Secretary, Economic Relations Division, Abu Saleh and Resident Co-ordinator of Swiss Agency for Development and Cooperation Philippe Besson signed the agreement on behalf of their respective governments.

An agreement with the World Bank for an amount of US dollar 32.40 million for the project was signed on September 29.

**2000 nurses to be appointed this year**  
The government will appoint 2,000 nurses in different hospitals of the country this year, reports UNB.

This was told at a national conference on "Strengthening Nursing Education and Services Project 1993-98" held at Hotel Sheraton yesterday.

Presided over by Secretary of the Health Ministry MM Reza, the discussants at the conference underscored the need for raising the number of nurses in hospitals.

A report presented by the team leader of the project, Janet James, revealed that there is only one nurse against three doctors, 13 patients and 10,500 people in the country.

However, the international standard is one doctor against 4 nurses.

Manik was a part-time employee of the Dhaka University Snacks (DUS) near TSC on the campus. He had been on the campus for nearly 12 years and liked in the TSC area.

Manik who hailed from Kishanganj, also used to collect flowers from different gardens inside the university and sold those to the students, his mates said.

**44 bottles of phensidyl seized, four arrested**  
SAVAR, Nov 3: Police arrested four people and recovered 44 bottles of phensidyl from their possession at Choto Bali Meher area here on Monday, reports UNB.
