According to police the incident took place when they were preparing brick chips at a road side place under a power supply

line at about 12.30 pm. Hospital sources quoting the injured and suddenly there was an explosion in the power supply line and a wire snapped.

Fatally injured Minoty was taken to the DMCH where the on duty doctors declared her dead. The body was sent to DMCH morgue for autopsy.
