Man killed over land dispute in Tangail

TANGAIL. Nov 9: An old man was killed and four people were injured in a clash between two rival groups of people over harvesting paddy at village Muraid in Ghatail thana today, reports UNB.

Police said the clash took place early in the morning when victim Janab Ali, 90, and his associates tried to resist his rivals as they went to cut and gather paddy cultivated by him on a disputed land. His body was sent to the hos-

pital morgue for autopsy. The injured, including Janab Ali's son Yusuf Ali, were admitted to Ghatail Thana Health Complex.

Meanwhile, police arrested two brothers — Motaleb Hossain and Moyez Uddin - in connection with the killing. A case was filed.
