Digital phone networks in all dist HQs by 2000 : Nasim

Telecommunications and Housing Minister Mohammad Nasim said yesterday that all the district headquarters would be brought under digital tele-phone networks by the year 2000, reports BSS.

He said work to bring 80 thana headquarters under digital telephone system has been undertaken.

The minister said two private companies had been entrusted with setting up of digital telephone exchanges at thana level, but they were yet to complete their assigned work satisfactorily. We are examining the agreements with those companies, he added.

To a supplementary from JP member Golam Faruq Ovi. Mohammad Nasim said the present government has broken monopoly in mobile telephone operation giving licenses to another three companies. He said the Telecommunications Ministry is still negotiating with the mobile operators to ex-tend maximum benefits to the subscribers including free incoming calls.
