BBA Program

ANNOUNCEMENT FOR ADMISSION (Session 1998-99)

Applications are invited for admission into the BBA program (session 1998-99).

Qualifications: A higher secondary certificate or its equivalent in Science, Arts, Commerce or other fields is the basic educational requirement. Minimum qualifying points for being eligible to apply is 5 (five) calculated on the following basis:

Certificates	1st Divn.	2nd Divn.
SSC or its equivalent	3	2
HSC or its equivalent	3	2

Students who have passed at least 5 (five) papers in GCE 'O' level and 2 (two) papers of 'A' level may also apply provided they have 5 points computed as below. Points for 'O' level and 'A' level are calculated on a 4-point scale (A = 4, B = 3, C = 2, D = 1). Method of computing points for the purpose of admission is given below:

GCE Exams.	Equivalent Divisions	
	First Division	Second Division
'O' Level	CGPA > = 3.0	1.5 < = CGPA < 3.0
'A' Level	CGPA > = 2.5	1.5 < = CGPA < 2.5

For all other foreign certificates, equivalence will be determined by the Institute.

Selection: All applicants are required to sit for an Admission Test which will be held at 10: A.M. on Friday, December 11, 1998. Candidates will be selected for interview on the basis of their standing in the admission test. Final selection for admission will be made on the basis of applicants' academic records, their performance in the admission test and in interview.

A student having a minimum score of 1200 (with a minimum of 400 in verbal) in SAT may not take the BBA admission test (written) administered by the Institute. But all the students must appear before a personal interview as a part of the admission requirements.

Application Procedure: Application form along with BBA Brochure will be available in Agrani Bank, Curzon Hall Branch, Dhaka University on payment of Tk.300.00 (non-refundable) from Sunday, November 15, 1998. Application form may also be obtained by mail from the BBA program office by sending a Bank Draft of Tk.300/- drawn in favour of BBA Admission, IBA along with a self addressed envelope (10" X 8") with postage stamp of Tk.35.00.

Candidates should submit the filled-in application forms to BBA Program Office between 9: a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on week days. The last date for receiving application is Sunday, December 6, 1998. For further information, please contact BBA Program Office, Telephone No. 868611.

Bangladesh festival in London in July

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina had a meeting with Anne Hunt, Director of the Bangladesh Festival to be held in London next July, reports UNB.

State Minister for Foreign Affairs, Abul Hassan Chowdhury, BOI Executive Chairman Farooq Sobhan and Festival Coordinator in Dhaka Mahjabeen Khan were present on the occasion.

The Prime Minister has become chief patron of the festival together with British Prime Minister Tony Blair.

The festival, planned for the next summer, is expected to be the largest event of its kind in Europe.

Over 20 of London's leading art venues are cooperating with the Festival organisers to produce a programme of exhibition, music, dance and theatre, film and photography, literature, textiles and crafts, cuisine and special outdoor events.

An investment seminar will also be held in London during the period highlighting the opportunities in Bangladesh available to foreign investors.

The seminar will jointly be organised by Bangladesh Board of Investment and the Department of Trade and Industry in Britain, said a BOI press release.

Druk Air to resume flights to Dhaka

'Druk Air', the national airline of Bhutan, will resume its flights to Dhaka from January as a partner of Bangladesh Biman after nearly eight months of a suspension, reports BSS.

The resumption follows an agreement signed between Bangladesh Biman, the national flag carrier, and Druk Air late last month for operations of the Bhutanese airline's flights on Paro-Dhaka-Bangkok sector, sources said. According to a message received yesterday, Saradindu Sekhar Chakma, Bangladesh ambassador to Bhutan, was informed by Druk Air office in Thimphu that flights to Dhaka will start from January 4, 1999.

The airlines 'stopped its operations to Dhaka in May this year because of financial inconsistencies with the particular flight route,' a report published on October 31 in 'Kunsel', the lone national weekly of Bhutan, said.

The agreement allows Druk Air to fly to Dhaka where passengers wishing to continue will then be transferred to a Biman flight to Bangkok, the weekly said.

The agreement will come for review after six months of the resumption of the operations.

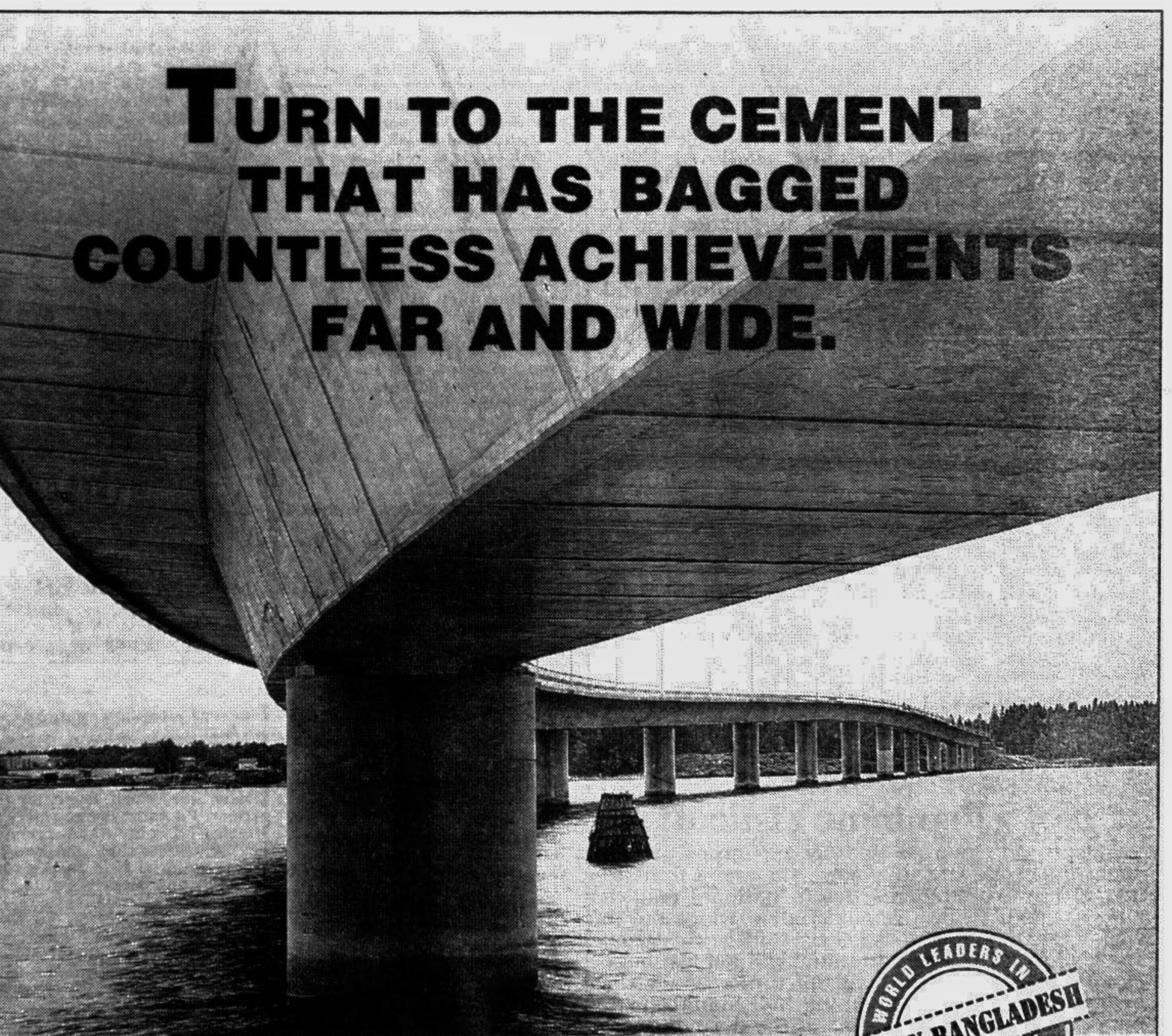
