Corretja falters early

MOSCOW, Nov 12 (AP/Reuters): Canadian Sebastian Lareau upset top-seeded Alex Corretja of Spain in the second round of the 1.1 million dollar Kremlin Cup on Wednesday.

For Lareau, a 25-year-old doubles specialist, it was the second upset of a top-ten player since 1996, when he dethroned Michael Stich of Germany, ranked fourth at that time.

After trading serve breaks early in the first set, both players held serve in the next two games, when Lareau broke Corretja three more times in the first set to win it 6-3.

"I played very well, I was returning very well," Lareau told reporters. "It was my last big tournament of the year, so I just wanted to go out and play as well as I can."

The Canadian closed the second set 6-3. "He was a tough opponent today. He was playing much better than me," Corretja, who has already qualified for the ATP Championship in Hanover, Germany, later this month.

German qualifier Lars Burgsmuller made his way to the quarterfinals as he ousted Sjeng Schalken of the Netherlands, 6-3, 5-7 while Guillaume Raoux of France defeated Paul Haarhuis of the Netherlands, 6-2, 7-5.

On Tuesday, Daniel Vacek and Marat Safin became the first seeded casualties when they were beaten in the first round.

Czech seventh seed Vacek did not put up much of the fight, losing 6-2, 6-4 in 56 minutes to Dutch qualifier Raemon Sluiter, who celebrated his first victory on the ATP Tour.

Russia's Safin, seeded eighth, was eliminated by another Dutchman, Paul Haarhuis, 6-3, 6-4 in 64 minutes.

In the last match on Centre Court at the Olympic Sky Sports Complex, hard-hitting 18-year-old Safin disappointed the home crowd, committing 25 unforced errors and landing only 47 per cent of his first serves.
