

1.2 lakh tonnes of foodgrains arrive in Ctg

CHITTAGONG, Nov 17: Six more ships carrying 1.2 lakh metric tonnes of foodgrain arrived at the seaport and dock workers readily began their unloading today, reports UNB. With this latest fleet some 48 ships laden with about 6.10 lakh MT grain have so far called at the Chittagong Port since September 17 after an emergency food import was forced by the last devastating floods in the country that washed away food crops. Port sources said another 10 vessels carrying 2.50 lakh tonnes of rice and wheat would arrive this month. They said 61 per cent of the food imports so far had been made by the government.

35 govt hatcheries hit by flood

Thirty-five of the total 122 government hatcheries in 29 districts of the country were affected by the recent floods, State Minister for Fisheries and Livestock Satish Chandra Roy told the Jatiya Sangsad yesterday, reports BSS.

BCL hails PM's 'no-hartal' call

Bangladesh Chhatra League DU unit held a rally in front of Aparajeyo Bangla on DU campus yesterday congratulating Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina for her recent announcement on hartal, reports UNB. The Prime Minister declared that her party will never call hartal in the country, even if it is in opposition in future. In the meeting, the BCL leaders said the Prime Minister's decision has been welcomed by every section of the society. They called upon the opposition BNP to announce similar declaration for the greater interest of the country. The BCL leaders said Awami League called hartals in the past but the situation then was different. They said BNP chairperson Begum Khaleda Zia is trying to create a chaotic situation in the country by calling frequent hartals when the government is busy with post-flood rehabilitation programmes.

Navy recovers smuggled goods worth Tk 69.63 lakh in Ctg

CHITTAGONG, Nov 17: Bangladesh Navy ships, during their routine anti-smuggling, anti-piracy and fishery protection patrol in the coastal areas, recently recovered smuggled goods worth about Taka 69.63 lakh, an ISPR press release said here today, reports BSS. Out of the four boats seized by Navy ships, three carrying 222 metric tons of smuggled foreign salt worth about Taka 54 lakh were impounded by the Bangladesh Navy ship 'Shapla' on Sunday. In another drive, a landing craft of Bangladesh Navy recovered about 460 cft of sundari wood worth about Taka 5 lakh from a mechanised boat from Arpanaisha under Patharghata on Friday. The seized goods, boats and the arrested persons were handed over to the appropriate authorities.

Implementation of post-flood rehabilitation programmes PM stresses mobilisation of internal resources

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday told the Jatiya Sangsad that the nation would have to mobilise its internal resources for successful implementation of post-flood rehabilitation and reconstruction programmes, reports BSS. "To make the nation self-reliant each capable citizen should make little self-sacrifice," the Prime Minister said in reply to a question from Hajji Mohammad Selim (AL, Dhaka). She also answered supplementaries on the issue from Prof Shahidul Islam (BNP-Kushtia) and Abdul Latif Mirza (AL-Serajganj). "It is true that we have received massive response from foreign countries for helping us in the post-flood rehabilitation," the Prime Minister said, adding, "Still, we have to tap our internal resources for this purpose."

The Prime Minister said the President promulgated the "Post-Flood Rehabilitation (Internal Resources Mobilisation) Ordinance 1998" as per provision of the Constitution. The ordinance, the first ever under this government, was promulgated by the President considering the urgency of the situation. She pointed out that during BNP government 113 ordinances were promulgated by the then president. The Prime Minister said that in response to the government's appeal 38 countries and 43 international agencies have made commitments to aid the post-flood rehabilitation and reconstruction endeavours. The countries are: Australia, Austria, Belgium, Bhutan, Canada, China, Denmark, Egypt, France, Germany, India, Italy, Japan, Jordan, Kuwait, Luxembourg, the Maldives, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Malaysia, Pakistan, Spain, Sri Lanka, Sweden, Switzerland, Thailand, Vietnam, the United Arab Emirates, the United Kingdom, the United States of America, Saudi Arabia, Nepal, Listanstan, Hong Kong, Ireland, Tunisia and Singapore.

In addition the World Bank will give 210 million dollars as supplementary financing against 13 ongoing projects. The Prime Minister said that 26 per cent of national highways, 15 per cent regional highways and 59 per cent of A-type feeder roads were affected by the flood. The international agencies included SIDA of Sweden, SGI of Japan, CIDA of Canada, OFDA of the United States, USAID, European Community, UNDP/OCH, World Food Programme, UNICEF, WHO, UNFPA, ADB, ETA/UA, OPEC, FAO, IDA, IRO of Saudi Arabia, UNHCR, UNESCO, AG Fund, ISF of OIC, World Muslim Congress of Pakistan, Ahlia Medical Group of UI, Human Measles Union and Action of Germany, NMC Hospital of UAE, French Pharmaceutical Industries of Paris, PARK Devis Pvt Ltd of Australia, Milupa of Germany, Red Cross-Canada, Red Cross-Denmark, Red Cross-Iceland, Red Cross-Korea, Red Cross-Sweden, Red Cross-Austria, Red Cross-UK, Red Cross-Germany, USRC, American Express, OISCA of Japan, and Solidarios of Spain. The Prime Minister said that a Japanese fact finding mission which visited the country from September 16 to 21, expressed keen interest to aid in post-flood rehabilitation. Another fact finding mission from Asian Development Bank also visited Bangladesh from Sept 19 to 23, she added. The Prime Minister told the Sangsad that Japan has requested World Food Programme (WFP) to give Bangladesh 1.5 million dollars' worth of rice from its share to the WFP. Besides, ADB will provide 133 million dollars while another 200 million dollars would be received soon from World Bank.
