এসএসসি ও এইচএসসি পরীক্ষায় এক বিষয়ে অকৃতকার্য পরীক্ষার্থীদের পরবর্তী সালের এসএসসি ও এইচএসসি পরীক্ষায় শুধুমাত্র অকৃতকার্য এক বিষয়ে অংশগ্রহণ প্রসঙ্গে শিক্ষা মন্ত্রণালয়ের ১১-১১-৯৮ তারিখের শিম/শঃ১০/সভা(বোর্ড)-২/৯৮/৬২৮ নং স্বাক্ষরে উল্লিখিত সভার ৫ নং সিদ্ধান্তের প্রেক্ষিতে সর্বাঙ্গীত সকলের অবগতির জন্য জানানো যাচ্ছে যে, ১৯৯৮ সালে অনুষ্ঠিত এসএসসি এবং এইচএসসি পরীক্ষায় অংশ গ্রহণ করে যেসব পরীক্ষার্থী শুধুমাত্র এক বিষয়ে ফেল করার কারণে অকৃতকার্য হয়েছে, সেসব পরীক্ষার্থী ১৯৯৯ সালে অনুষ্ঠিতব্য এসএসসি এবং এইচএসসি পরীক্ষায় রেজিস্ট্রেশনের মেয়াদ থাকলে ইচ্ছা করলে শুধু অকৃতকার্য এক বিষয়ে (উভয় অংশ/পত্র) পরীক্ষা দিতে পারবে এবং পাস করলে এসব পরীক্ষার্থীর ফলাফল "বিশেষ পাস" হিসাবে প্রদান করা হবে, কোন বিভাগ (১ম, ২য় ও ৩য়) প্রদান করা হবে না। প্রসঙ্গত উল্লেখ্য, এ ব্যবস্থা ঐচ্ছিক হিসাবে গণ্য করা হবে, অর্থাৎ এ জাতীয় কোন পরীক্ষার্থী ইচ্ছা করলে একাধিক বিষয়ে অকৃতকার্য পরীক্ষার্থীদের ন্যায় সকল বিষয়েও পরীক্ষা দিতে পারবে। এক বিষয়ে অকৃতকার্য পরীক্ষার্থীরা অব্যবহিত পরবর্তী বছরের পাবলিক পরীক্ষায় অংশগ্রহণ করে পাস করলে তাদের পাসের সনদ পরবর্তী সালের হবে এবং তাদের দুই বছরের পরীক্ষার জন্য ২টি নম্বরপত্র ইস্যু করা হবে। উল্লেখ্য একাধিক বিষয়ে অকৃতকার্য পরীক্ষার্থীদের ক্ষেত্রে এ ঐচ্ছিক নিয়ম প্রযোজ্য হবে না। তাদের সকল পরীক্ষায় অংশগ্রহণ করতে হবে। পরবর্তী নির্দেশ না দেয়া পর্যন্ত এ ব্যবস্থা পরবর্তী বছরগুলির জন্য অব্যবহিতভাবে বহাল থাকবে।

Atia forest: 618 cases now pending, JS told

Minister for Environment and Forests Sajeda Chowdhury yesterday said that the government was fully aware of the issue regarding the Atia forests located in Tangail, Mymensingh and Gazipur districts, reports BSS.

Replying to a call attention notice brought by Abul Kalam Azad Siddique (BNP-Tangail) in the Jatiya Sangsad, she said various settlement surveys in the past had recorded the lands of the vast 59,648.20 acre Atia forests under individuals ownership.

"The persons demanding ownership of the lands on the basis of those survey records also filed nearly 618 cases which are now pending in law courts," she said.

The minister told the House that the Atia Forest Act was introduced by the martial law government in 1982 as an ordinance, but its process began in 1979-1980.

The BNP legislator in his notice claimed that the present government was taking steps to evict the settlers from the Atia Forest area, but the minister said it was not true. "The present government has no plan to evict the settlers from the Atia forest area but has involved them in the creation of agricultural forestry under the financial assistance of the Asian Development Bank (ADB)," she said.

Discussion on thoughts of Amartya Sen held

Country's leading economists yesterday opined that the planners usually display reluctance to adopting alternative discourses like Amartya Sen's real life economics, reports BSS.

"Ingenuous discourses of Amartya Sen (in the field of economics) has paved new avenues for addressing Third

World issues including poverty alleviation," they observed.

Prof Rehman Sobhan, Prof Anisur Rahman, Prof Mozaffer Ahmed and Prof Wahid Uddin Mahmud participated in the discussion titled "Thoughts of Amartya Sen" in "Kala Bhaban" of the University of Dhaka here.

Termining nobel laureate Amartya Sen as a great humanitarian economist Prof Rehman Sobhan stressed the need for reading his talented works on society, culture, ethics and philosophy.

He said we have to change our mind-set and judge Sen as a philosopher rather than as a mere economist who had produced voluminous works on hunger and famine.

Critically evaluating the contributions of Amartya Sen, Prof Anisur Rahman said he didn't touch the political economy analyzing the dominant socio-political structure. "He wished to explain the things in economic and philosophical arena not in the political economy," he observed.

Prof Wahiduddin Mahmud said Dr Sen broke the traditional format of analyzing development patterns in terms of income distribution introducing a new paradigm of measuring developments considering equity and social justice. He said Sen thought on welfare within the family removing all sorts of disparity including gender discrimination.

"Amartya had a pioneering role to inspire the recent ideological changes in the world on reform of the existing free market economy," he added.

Dr MM Akash of economics department moderated the discussion attended by a number of faculty members, economists and students.

Indian Navy chief due Nov 22

Indian Chief of Naval Staff Admiral Vishnu Bhagwat arrives in the city on November 22 on a five-day visit, reports UNB.

During his visit, Admiral Bhagwat will call on President Shahabuddin Ahmed and Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina.

He will also meet the chiefs of Army, Navy and Air Force and visit Naval Establishments in Dhaka, Kaptai and Chittagong.

Bhagwat will be accompanied by Mrs Nilufer Bhagwat, a lawyer of the Indian High Court and Supreme Court.

Organised by the "Freedom-Fighter Noorul Kader Memorial Committee" the programme was attended by the eminent citizens and cultural activists of the country.

Speakers at the meeting said that Noorul Kader would remain alive in the hearts of the people for long for his role in the Liberation War.

The speakers also recollected various events of his colourful life at the meeting.

Poet Shamsur Rahman presided over the programme. The meeting was addressed among others by Barrister Ishfaq Ahmed, Dr Anisuzzaman, Khandaker Asaduzzaman, IIT Imam, Prof Rehman Sobhan, Dr Raza Khan Amin, Enayet Ullah Khan, A M A Muhiit and Reshesh Moitra.

Noorul Kader died of heart attack on September 13 in this year in London when he went there in connection with admission of his daughter.
