BCL submits 17-pt demand to DU VC

Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) yesterday announced that they would implement a 'master plan' to face the challenges of 21st century in the different educational institutes of the country including the Dhaka University.

They submitted a 17-point demand to the Vice-Chancellor of DU in this regard. The newly elected BCL leaders said this during a meeting with reporters of different dailies at the teachers lounge of Teachers Students Centre (TSC).

The BCL leaders told the reporters that they had asked VC set up a Computer Village on the campus to enable the student acquire skills that will give them better job opportunities.

Dhaka elected OPCW member
Bangladesh was elected an executive member of the Organisation for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons (OPCW) for a two-year term, reports APB.

Of the 41 members of the council, Bangladesh was elected alongwith five other countries from the Asian Group for the term beginning from May 1999, said an official source yesterday.

The council is the executive organ of the Organisation for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons (OPCW) based in the Hague.
