Bangladesh Awami League will celebrate the first anniversary of signing of the historic Chittagong Hill Tracts (CHT) peace accord in a befitting manner, reports BSS.

Awami League general secretary and LGRD and Cooperatives Minister Zillur Rahman yesterday called upon the party leaders and workers as well as peace-loving people across the country to observe the day on December 2 with due honour.

Tk 4 cr distributed among widows, distressed women

Over Tk 4.03 crore was distributed among the widows and distressed women abandoned by their husbands in October from the Prime Minister's Relief and Welfare Fund, reports UNB.

State Minister for Social Welfare Dr Mozammel Hossain informed the Jatiya Sangsad during the question hour yesterday.

He said 4,03,110 distressed women received Tk 100 each. Replying to Gazi Mohammad Shahjahan (BNP), the State Minister said ten women were selected from each ward of the unions across the country.

There was no provision of providing financial help to the distressed women directly from any department under his ministry, Dr. Mozammel said replying to a supplementary.

He told Shah Mohammad Abul Hussain (BNP) that the government through the Women Affairs Division and the National Women Organisation has taken up various steps to create employment opportunities for the distressed women.

Exhibition on tourism ends

Bangladesh took part in the four-day exhibition on tourism, World Travel Market, held at Earls Court, London from November 16 to 19, reports APB.

This year's theme of the exhibition was 'Retaining a world in which our children can live and work without deprivation'.

Bangladesh Parjatan Corporation, Biman Bangladesh Airlines, Hotel Agrabad and different tour operators of the country participated in the fair.

As many as 5,000 exhibitors from 160 countries, representing every sector of tourism, participated in the event this year, said a message received in the city yesterday.

Nobel laureate calls on Hasina

Nobel laureate Mairead McGuire and Secretary General of the Nobel-Laureates Campaign for Children of the World Pierre Marchand called on Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina at her Ganobhaban residence yesterday after a trip to the hill districts, reports UNB.

Mairead McGuire said they are working to promote peace, non-violence and welfare of children.

The Irish Nobel Peace Prize winner praised the Chittagong Hill Tracts peace accord and said restoration of peace through negotiations in CHT inspired them to bring peace in the trouble-torn Northern Ireland.

She said, 'We have already visited the CHT area and are impressed to see the development of ethnic culture and heritage. A peaceful atmosphere is existing there.'

The Prime Minister said her government is committed to promote peace and human rights and it had solved the CHT problems after two decades without any third-party mediation.

She said all those who had migrated to India came back, surrendered their arms and were now living a peaceful and normal life. 'We have taken all-out measures for the development of the region.'

Hasina agreed with the delegation that the Third World debts should be converted to grants.

Referring to the women and children issue, she said the government laid special emphasis on woman and child development.

Zillur says

'Upazila Parishads to fulfil hopes of people'

LGRD and Cooperatives Minister Zillur Rahman yesterday said that the government has taken up initiatives for constituting strong Upazila Parishads to fulfil the hopes and aspirations of the people, reports BSS.

'Adequate training programmes for improving the efficiency of the elected representatives of the Upazila Parishad would be taken under UNDP project,' he said while presiding over a meeting of the governing body of the National Institute for Local Government in the conference room of the local government ministry.

The LGRD minister stressed the need for increasing the institutional efficiency of all pourashavas and union parishads.

He said the government has taken up a project with the financial help of UNDP at a cost of Taka 50 crore for capacity-building of local governance.

The meeting was informed that nearly 60,000 elected representatives, including chairmen of all pourashavas and union parishads, would be trained up under the UNDP project.

Local Government Secretary A H M Abdul Hai and Rural Development and Cooperatives Secretary Abhab Ahmed, representatives from different ministries and chiefs of different organisations were present at the meeting.

'Shifting of Aricha ghat not before 2000'

Shipping Minister A S M Abdur Rob yesterday informed the House that an inter-ministerial meeting held recently decided to shift the 'Natakhol-Aricha' ferry ghat to 'Latipur-Aricha' route after construction of a link road with two bridges to maintain communication between Dhaka and several Northern districts, reports BSS.

'But the Communication Ministry informed the Shipping Ministry that this shift will take time for implementation up to the year 2000,' he said while responding to a question raised by Md Wazuddin Khan of Awami League at the Jatiya Sangsad.

The Shipping Minister said provision was made to operate the ferry service on this important route by shifting it temporarily at Kazirhat till the final shifting to the scheduled place.

He said the present route between Aricha-Natakhol could hardly be kept operative due to lack of navigability during the dry seasons and floods during the monsoon.

'Even dredging can hardly help maintain navigability on the present route,' he told the House.
