Venables signed a three-year contract with first division English club Palace six months ago after moving from Poretsmouth, which he bought in 1996.

He said at the time that Palace, the first club he managed in a colourful career that has also taken him to Queen's Park Rangers, Barcelona in Spain and Tottenham Hotspur in the last 17 years, could also be his last club job.

Venables took England to the semifinals of the 1996 European championship but failed to take Australia to the World Cup last northern summer after they lost a playoff to

British police said last weekend they were investigating the transfer of a number of Australian players to Portsmouth during Venables' time at the club.

Thai plea rejected

BANGKOK, Nov 28 (AP): Thailand's attempts to convince Saudi Arabia to participate in the upcoming 13th Asian Games have failed, the Bangkok Post reported Saturday.

Thai Olympic Committee Chairman Gen Chettha Thanajaro told the Bangkok Post he sent a last-minute plea to his Saudi counterpart but has received no response.

Saudi Arabia's sudden withdrawal from the December 6-20 Games has dismayed the hosts who remain skeptical about the reasons offered for the pull-out last week.

Saudi sports authorities said the Games conflicted with national centenary celebrations and the Muslim holy month of Ramadan.
