

Army chief leaves for India

Chief of Army Staff Lt Gen M Mustafizur Rahman yesterday left for India on a week-long visit at the invitation of Indian Chief of Army Staff General Ved Prakash Malik, reports UNB.

He is accompanied by his wife Begum Rashida Mustafiz and a three-member delegation, said an ISPR release.

During his stay in India, General Mustafiz will review the passing-out parade at the Indian Military Academy at Dehradun as a reviewing officer.

He will call on Indian State Minister for External Affairs and the Foreign Secretary, the Chief of Army Staff and the Chief of Naval Staff.

The Chief of Army Staff will also visit a formation headquarters.
