Members of the Shaheed families, two freedom fighters from each district, and a representative of freedom fighters from each thana will be invited to attend the reception.

'Fatwa is a violation of human rights'

A UN human rights official yesterday said *fatwa* against women is a violation of human rights and called for building strong public resistance against it, reports UNB.

"Some people make their own laws. *fatwa* is one of the examples. It is totally illegal," said Salma Khan, head of the UN Committee on Elimination of Discrimination Against Women, at a meeting of Rotary Club of Ramna at Dhaka Club.

Ms Khan regretted that there has been no move to punish those who issue *fatwa* against women, even though the practice violates the country's laws.

Saying that Bangladesh has a poor status of human rights, she regretted that even the good laws are not equally applied.

"It's a pity that even the constitutional rights are not applied equally," she said.

According to Ms Khan, not more than 20 per cent of the country's population enjoy human rights.

The human rights are linked to a country's socio-economic status. The country should spend more on education, health and social development to ensure better human rights to its people, she said.

The meeting was presided over by the club's President Shahadath Ali.
