The UNICEF report on 'The State of the World's Children 1998' was presented to President Shahabuddin Ahmed yesterday, reports APB.

Shahida Azfar, UNICEF representative in Bangladesh, handed over the report to the President at Bangabhaban.

The main focus of this year's report is on education and highlights of key actions to be taken in a rights-based approach to ensure quality education for all children of the world, including Bangladesh.

The UNICEF official mentioned that over 130 million children, including 73 million girls of primary school age in developing countries were growing up without access to basic education.

The world can no longer afford such an enormous waste of human potential, she observed.
