One arrested with firearms

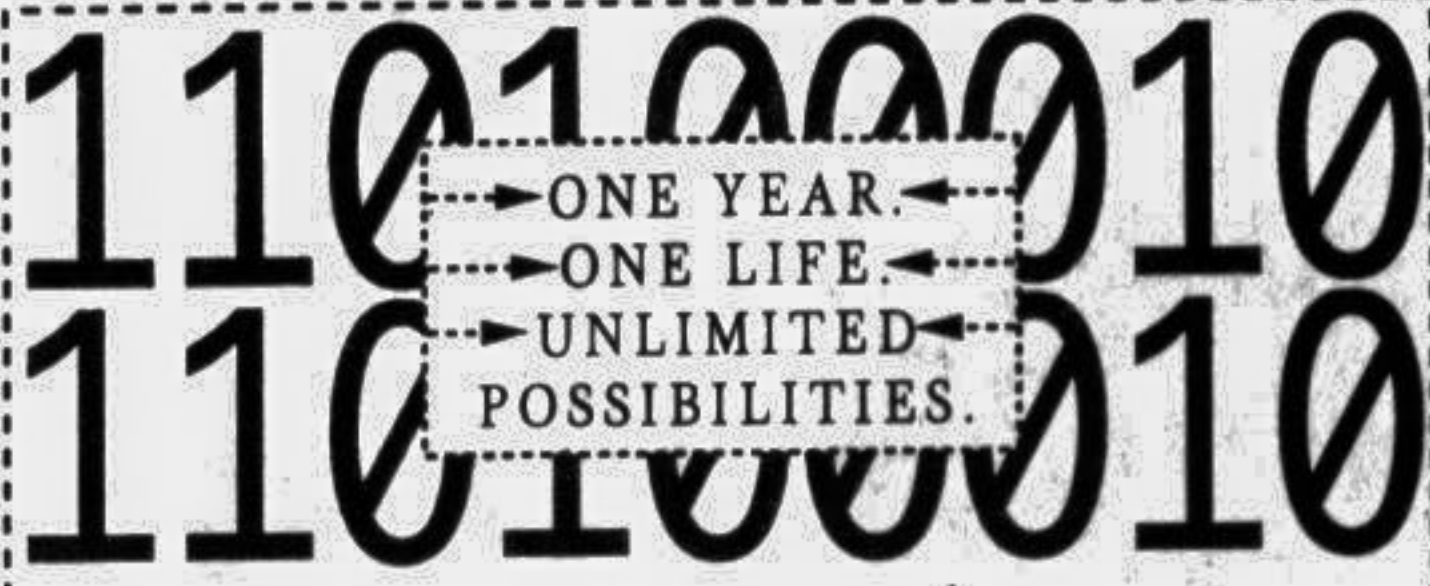
Police in a drive arrested one person with firearms from a hotel in city's Kamalapur area on Thursday night, reports UNB.
