Foundation of two bridges laid

Barisal to be given city corpn status: Hasina

BARISAL, Dec 12: Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina laid the foundation of two bridges here today saying that her government is making all-out efforts to develop a strong communications network to ensure a smooth economic growth in the country, reports UNB.

The two bridges at Doarika and Shikarpur on Barisal-Faridpur highway, some 18 and 21 kms respectively from the Barisal town, will be constructed at a cost of Tk 112.76 crore with the Kuwait government contributing the lion's share.

The bridges are scheduled to be completed within 33 months. Addressing the foundation-laying ceremony at Doarika ferry ghat in the morning, the Prime Minister said, "Economic development can't be ensured without a strong communications system, an integral part of the total infrastructure."

The present government believes in balanced development of all parts of the country, she said, acknowledging that the country's southern part, detached from the mainland by many rivers, could not yet achieve the desired progress.

Hasina said her government attaches priority to communications sector and would construct more bridges over the river, in the southern part.

Although Barisal was declared a division, it has not yet got the required infrastructure, she said, assuring that Barisal will be given city corporation status, and an education board and one of the planned 12 universities of science and technology will be set up there.

Describing the communications network a pre-condition to socio-economic uplift, the Prime Minister said the government wants to build a smooth communications link at all levels — from union to thana, thana to district and district to capital.

She mentioned the recent opening of the Bangabandhu Jamuna Bridge directly linking the northern parts with the capital.

Initial work is going on to facilitate construction of the Padma Bridge, a long-cherished desire of the people of the southern parts, she said. "But it's a giant project and will take time to implement."

Hasina listed the progress of some other bridges and said a newly-constructed bridge on Dhaleswari river will open today.

Construction of the Tk 453 crore Bhairab Bridge on the Dhaka-Sylhet highway is progressing while work on the Tk 570 crore Paksey Bridge over the Padma has already begun, she added.

Meanwhile, she mentioned, feasibility study is going on for the construction of the Rupsa Bridge.

The Prime Minister said her party has not forgotten its election-pledges and is fully committed to implementing those one by one.

She referred to the century's worst flooding this year that caused colossal damages to roads and bridges and stalled the progress of construction work, and said the government took prompt action to rehabilitate and reconstruct those.

Giving a picture of the government endeavours to improve the country's communications system, Hasina said Karotoa Bridge on Thakurgaon-Panchagarh road, Langaband Bridge on Dhaka-Chittagong highway and Dharia Bridge on Hemayetpur-Singail road have been opened for transport.

Construction of Gabkhan Bridge on Barisal-Pirojpur road, Daratana Bridge on Pirojpur-Bagerhat road, Hariadaspur Bridge on Maizkandi-Gopalganj road and Mollarhat Bridge is also in progress, she added.

Communication Minister Anwar Hossain Manju, Commerce and Industries Minister Tofail Ahmed, Chief Whip Abul Hasnat Abdullah, Awami League Presidium member Amir Hossain Amu, Roads and Railway Division Secretary Syed Rezaul Hayat, and Roads and Highways Chief Engineer Abdul Wadud also spoke at the function.
