

Trial of killers of martyred intellectuals demanded

Speakers at a discussion meeting in the city yesterday demanded trial of the killers of martyred intellectuals in special court so that nobody could ever dare commit such crime against humanity, reports BSS. They recalled that the collaborators of the Pakistani occupation forces anticipating sure defeat, brutally killed a number of heroic sons of the soil including some illustrious journalists at the fag end of the Liberation War to create a vacuum in the intellectual arena. The speakers paid rich tributes to those heroic sons of the soil who made supreme sacrifices and embraced martyrdom in the hands of "Rajakar", "Al-badr" and "Al-shams" and other collaborators of the occupation forces. Held at the Jatiya Press Club in observance of the Martyred Intellectuals' Day, the discussion was jointly organised by Bangladesh Federal Union of Journalists (BFUJ) and Dhaka Union of Journalists (DUJ). Presided over by BFUJ president Iqbal Sobhan Chowdhury, the discussion was addressed,

among others, by union leaders Abul Kalam Azad, Shafiqur Rahman, Azizul Islam Bhuiyan, Akhter Ahmed Khan, Manzurul Ahsan Bulbul, Swapan Kumar Saha. Noted litterateur and journalist Syed Abul Maksud and elderly social worker Saleha Anwaruddin also spoke on the occasion.

'War Film Week' from Dec 17

Dhaka University Film Society (DUFFS) has organised 'War Film Week '98' from December 17 to mark Victory Day, reports UNB. The War Film Festival will be dedicated to eminent filmmaker and freedom fighter Shaheed Zahir Raihan. The slogan of the festival is "Film for Freedom." DUFFS disclosed this at a press conference yesterday at TSC and said the holocaust and panic of war touched the human being in different times and the filmmaker had depicted those horror in celluloid. Some 23 war-based films, including Vietnam War, Second World War, Stop Genocide, Muktiir Gaan, Agooner Parashmoni, War and Peace, Brave Heart, A Tell of Two Cities, All Quiet On The Western Front, Land and Freedom and Judgement at Nuremberg, will be screened in the festival. On the inaugural day on December 17, State Minister for Youth, Sports and Cultural Affairs, Obaidul Quader will attend the function as chief guest while Nasiruddin Yusuf Bachchu, Shariar Kabir and Raisul Islam Asad will be present as special guests. The inaugural programme will be presided over by DU Vice Chancellor Prof A K Azad Chowdhury while DUFFS moderator Prof Dr AAMS Arefin Siddique will be present as key speaker. At the concluding session of the film week on December 23, State Minister for Information Prof Abu Syed will be present as chief guest while prominent filmmaker Subhas Datta, Badal Rahman will be present as special guests.
