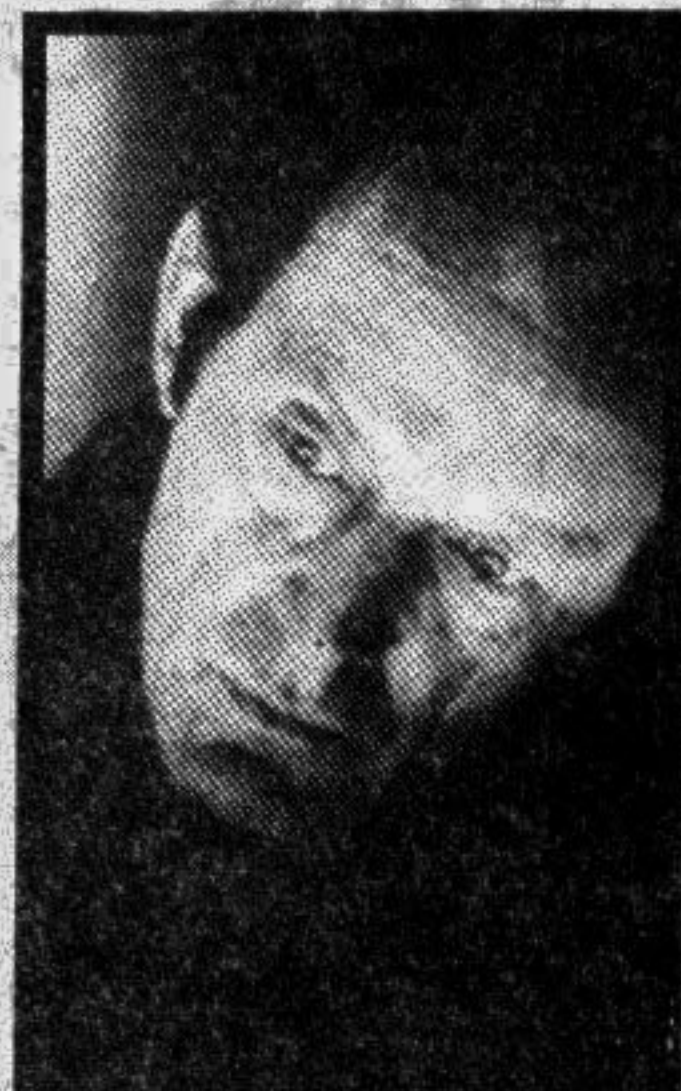


Pick of the week

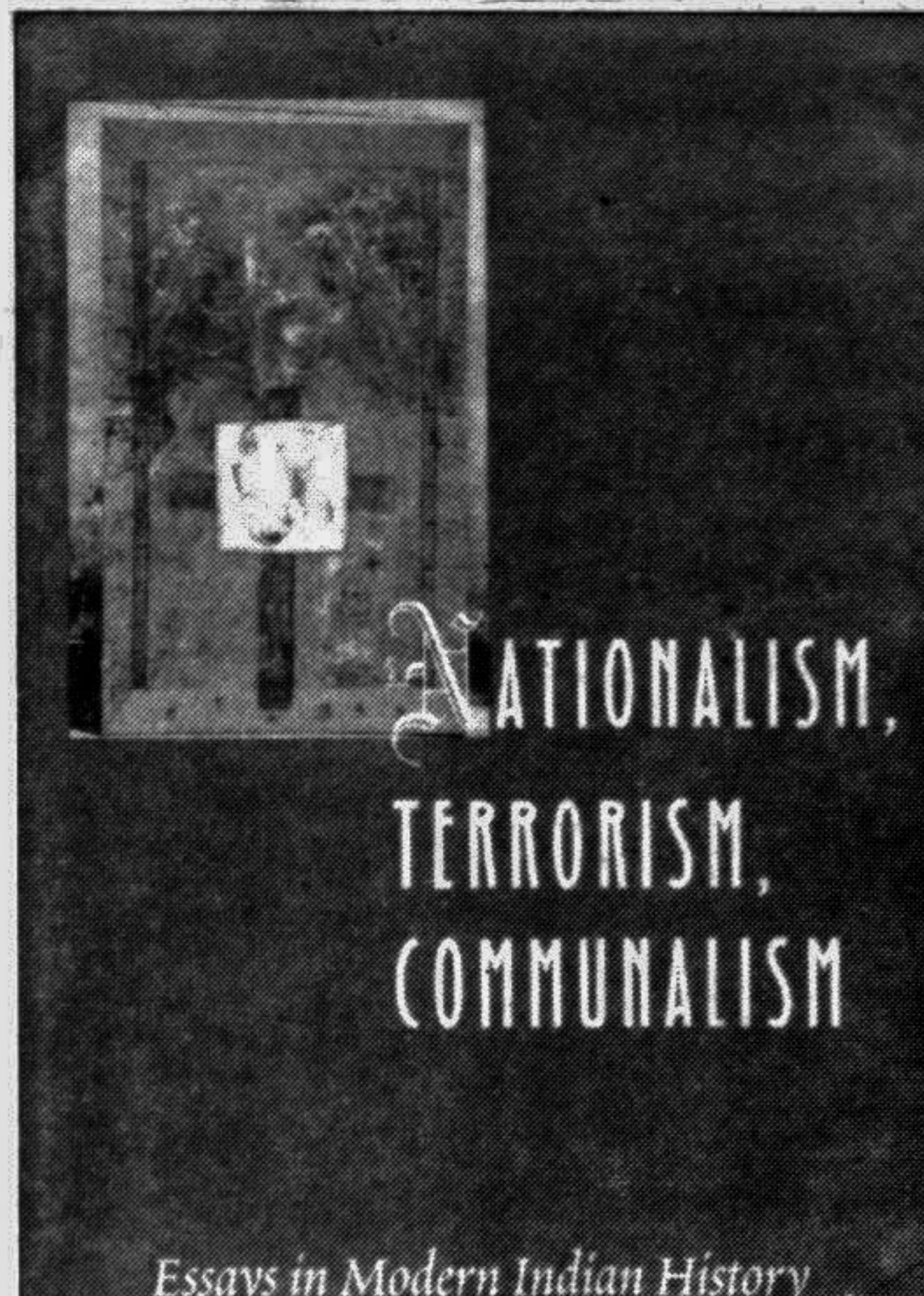


ALL ABOUT FABRICS

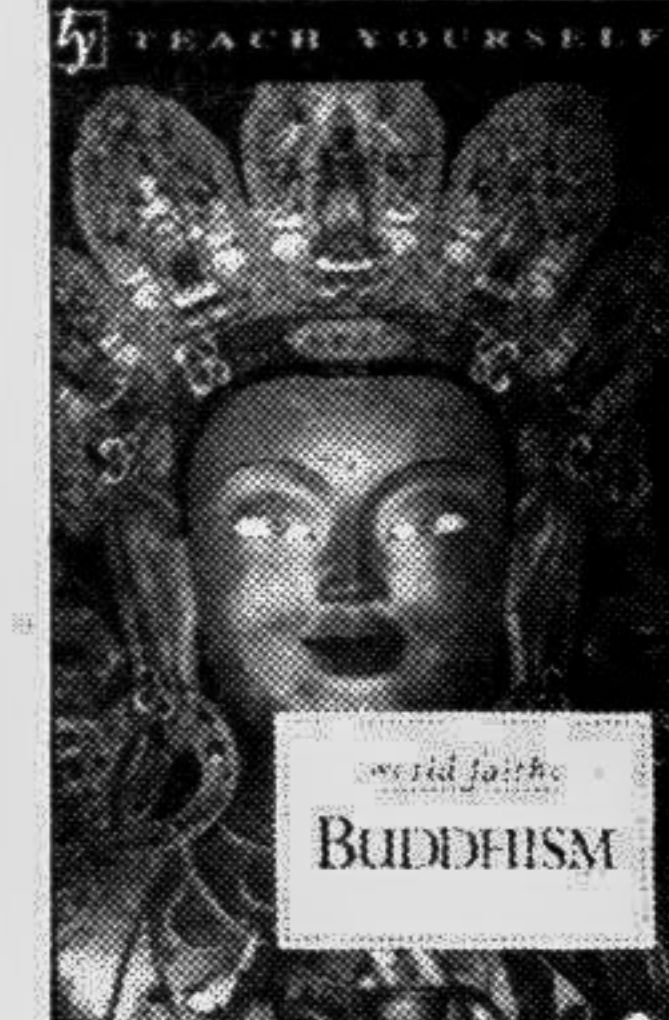
NATIONALISM, TERRORISM, COMMUNALISM

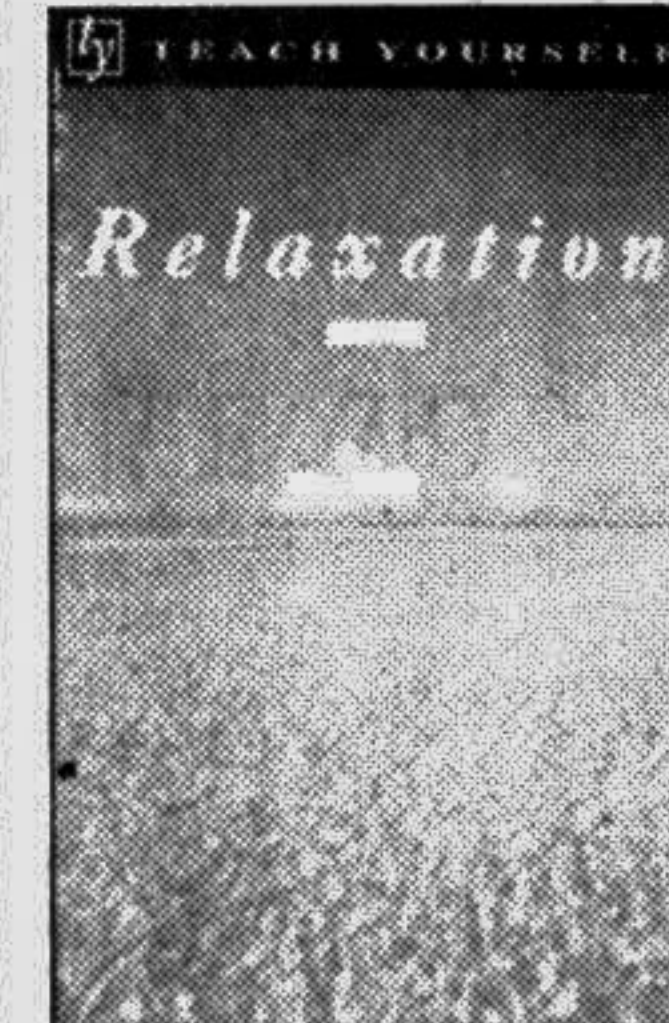

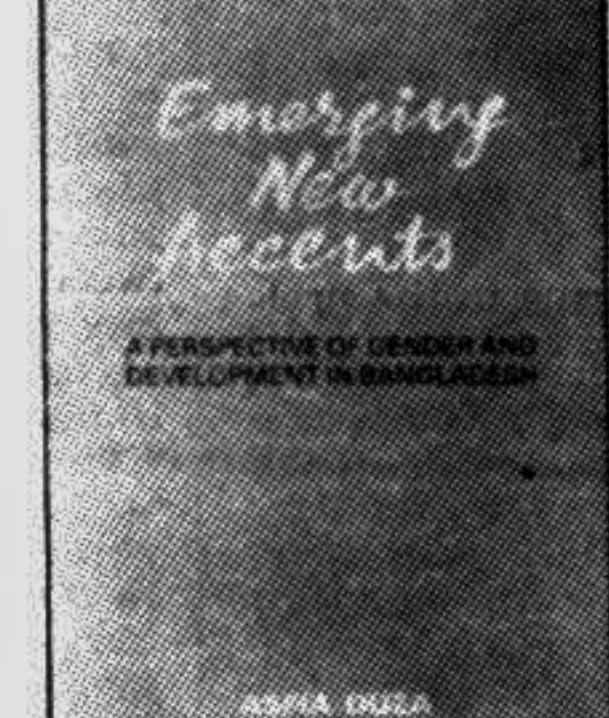

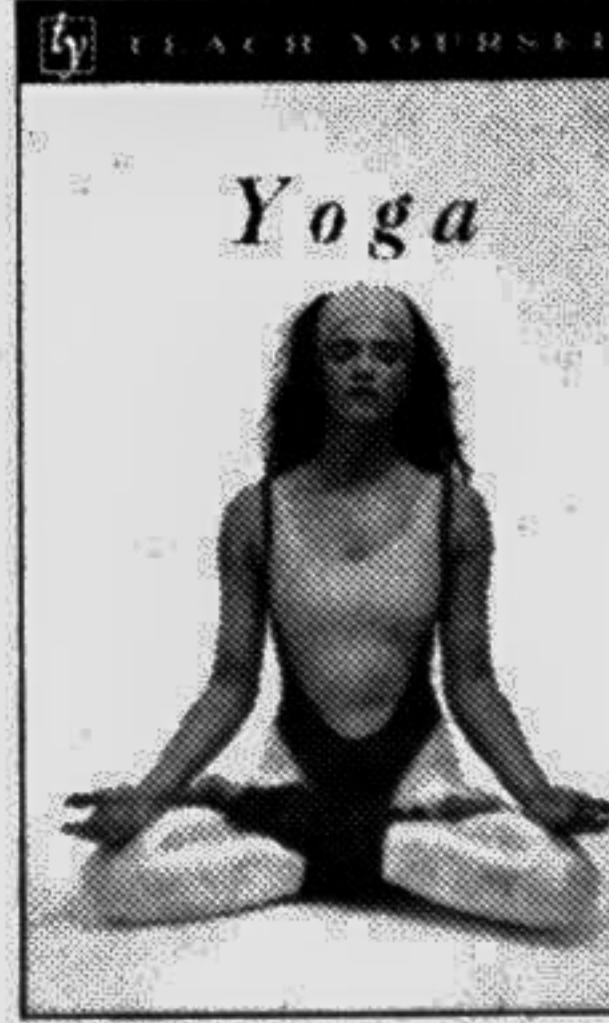
