Sayed stresses need for projecting life, society & country on BTV

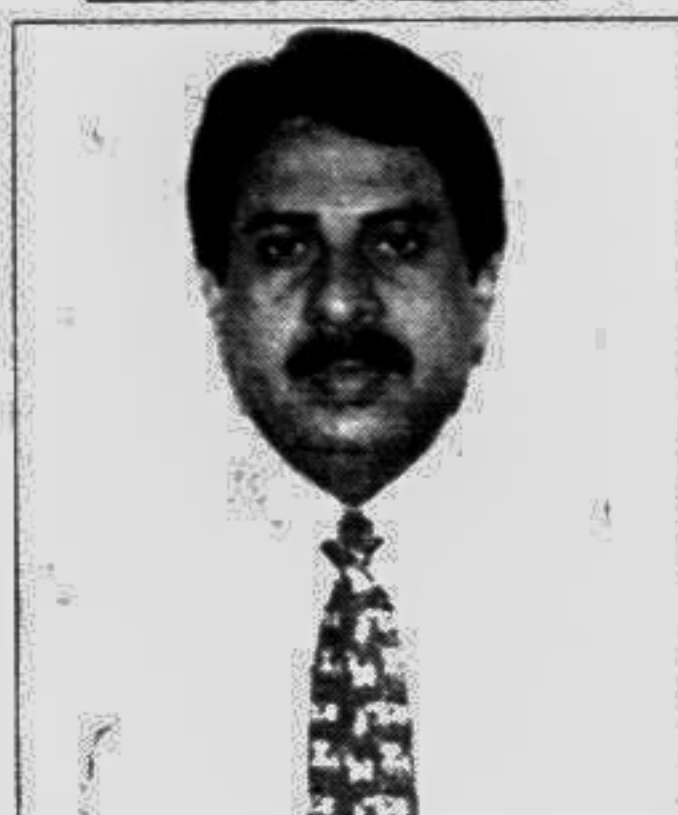

Abdul Jabbar Khan's death anniversary today

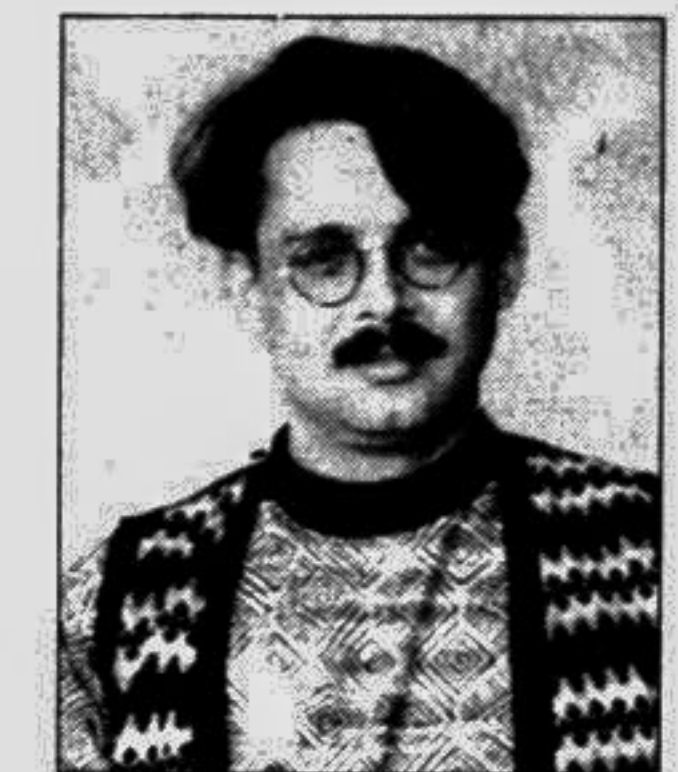
The 5th death anniversary of Abdul Jabbar Khan, a pioneer of the country's film industry and a veteran freedom fighter, will be observed tomorrow.
