

#### Lalmatia beat Eskaton

An all-round performance by Alam Babu enabled Lalmatia Club to beat Eskaton Sabuj Sangha by 15 runs in the opening match of the Metropolis First Division cricket league at City Club ground yesterday, reports UNB.

Sent in to bat, Lalmatia were all out for 176 in 49.4 overs. But later they restricted Eskaton Sabuj Sandha 161 in 48 overs to register the first victory in the league.

Lalmatia opener Alam Babu top scored 15 off 99 balls. He also captured three wickets conceding only 29 runs.

Pakistani Abid Hanif contributed 40 in 62 balls with four fours and one down R J Rubaiyat made 27 off 60 balls hitting three boundaries for the winners.

AR Hira was the most successful bowler for Eskaton claiming three for 34 while B Turki took two for 39.

Shahidul fought hard for Eskaton contributing highest 43 off 48 balls featuring two fours and a six. Opener Sajid Ali scored 24 in 54 balls with three boundaries and number eight bat Khorshed Alam made 23 in 26 deliveries with a four.

Excepting Babu's three wickets, Aminul of Lalmatia took three wickets conceding 26 runs in ten overs including two maidens while Khokon and Shudan took one wicket a piece.

**Corretja, Moya to play in Adidas**

SYDNEY, Dec 27: Spaniards Alex Corretja and Carlos Moya have signed on for January's Adidas International warmup to the Australian Open, tournament organisers said Wednesday, reports AFP.

The addition of Corretja, the world No 3, and Moya, No 5 in the world, meant six of the world's top 10 male players would be at Sydney's White City for the tournament, tournament director Barry Masters said.

Also expected in the men's draw are Australia's Patrick Rafter (No. 4), defending champion Karol Kucera (No. 8), Greg Rusedski (No. 9), and Richard Krajicek (No. 10).

The women's field includes world No. 1 Lindsay Davenport and No. 2 Martina Hingis.


## Superb Surjo Tarun devour Mohammedans' long tail

**Mohammedan Sporting** tasted their first defeat after three consecutive wins when the popular Motijheel outfit surrendered to Surjo Tarun by 39 runs in the most dreadful manner in a Janakantha Premier League match at the Bangabandhu National Stadium yesterday.

Mohammedan, chasing a commanding Surjo Tarun total of 319 for eight in the stipulated 80 overs, could manage 280 before being all out in 74.4 overs. But with a couple of thousand loyal supporters attending, Mohammedan were only to be blamed for yielding from a winning position, losing their last seven wickets for the addition of only 13 runs to the total.
