Govt taken up \$60m judicial, legal capacity building project

The government has taken up a judicial and legal capacity building project involving 60 million US dollars for increasing efficiency of the judicial and legal system, reports BSS.

Official sources told BSS yesterday that the World Bank will provide 45 million US dollars for the project of which 9.5 million US dollars have been earmarked for legal and regulatory capacity building, 11 million US dollars for judicial capacity building, 20 million US dollars for improved court and other infrastructure and 4.5 million US dollars for project implementation unit.

The government will provide rest of the amount and the Ministry of Law and Justice will implement the project.

According to the sources, the main objective of the project is to increase efficiency of the judicial and legal system through improvement of the legal framework, streamlining the

system of courts and strengthening the judicial capacity and providing improved access to justice.

The government is negotiating with the World Bank for reaching an agreement with it by April next year so that the project could be launched in the middle of next year, they said.

The sources said the government is completing all its procedural requirements including approval of Technical Assistance Project Profile (TAPP), Project Concept Paper (PCP) and Project Profile (PP) before signing the agreement.

A series of meetings were held between the government and the World Bank on the loan negotiation for the project, said a senior official of the government.

He said the World Bank in its board meeting on March next year may give approval of the credit for the project.

Steps taken to ensure adequate supply of water in city: Zillur

LGRD Minister Zillur Rahman yesterday said that an initiative to implement the development and extension of WASA lines was taken to ensure adequate supply of water in Dhaka city and the adjoining areas, reports UNB.

The project will cost Tk 3,000 crore, the minister told French Ambassador in Dhaka Renee Veyret, who called on him at his office to discuss about cooperation of her government in development of infrastructure for augmenting water supply in the city.

The minister also informed the ambassador about the progress of post-flood rehabilitation and reconstruction work and lauded the continued support of the French government in constructing the water supply infrastructure and development in other social sectors.

Lankan Peace council team meets Speaker

The visiting 16-member high-level delegation of National Peace Council of Sri Lanka called on Speaker Hasmayun Rasheed Chowdhury at Sangsab Bhaban yesterday, reports UNB.

Sri Lankan Social Welfare Minister Berbie Prenatal Disanayake led the delegation, which included government high officials, opposition parliament members, Buddhist monks, journalists and human rights activists.

During the meeting, they exchanged views on various matters relating to mutual interests of the two countries.
