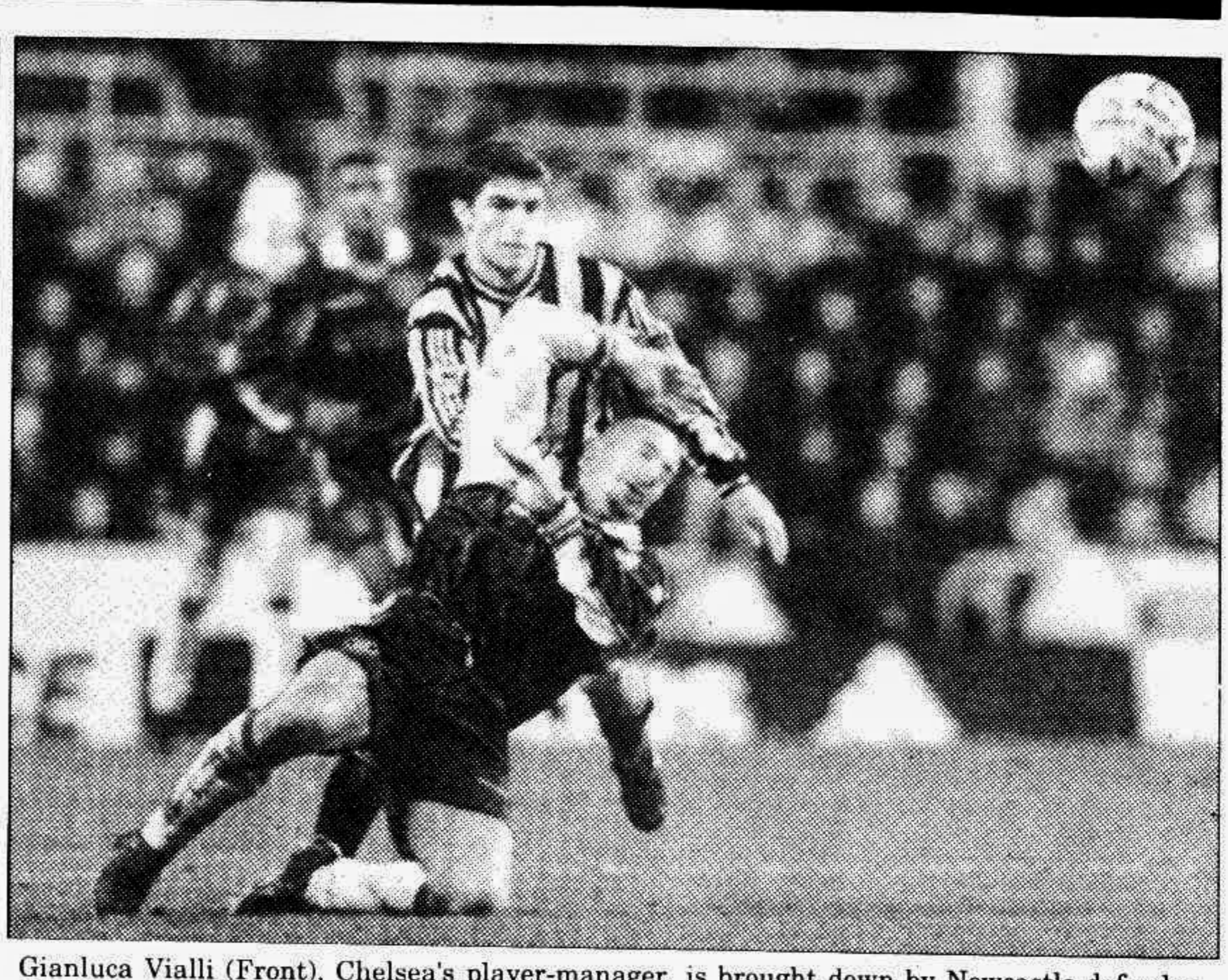

Big shots may testify in Gil case MADRID, Jan 10 (Reuters/Internet). The presidents of four Spanish football teams are expected to be called to testify in the case in which Atletico Madrid president Jesus Gil is accused of illegally funneling funds to the team, a newspaper reported on Sunday. Gil, also the mayor of the southern resort town of Marbella, was jailed on Thursday on charges of embezzlement and falsifying documents related to publicity contracts signed between Marbella and Atletico Madrid. The first division Spanish football club has sported the Marbella name on the front of their jerseys in recent seasons. Now the presidents of Real Betis, Valladolid, Mallorca and Sevilla are expected to be called to appear before Judge Santiago Torres, La Vanguardia newspaper reported. It said all four of the teams have worn the Marbella name in the past. Gil's lawyer Jose Luis Sierra -- himself on five million pesetas (\$34,800) bail -- has appealed the judge's decision to jail Gil without bail for allegedly channelling 450 million pesetas (\$3.17 million) of Marbella city funds to Atletico Madrid. Citing medical reasons, Sierra has requested a change in the conditions on the arrest to allow Gil to be released on bail. The former deputy mayor of Marbella, Pedro Roman, was also jailed on the same charges on Thursday but Enrique Cerezo, vice-president of Atletico Madrid, was freed on bail. Gil, the flamboyant Atletico president, reportedly told the judge he did not discover the deal to put Marbella's name on the Atletico jerseys until he saw the shirts. He said Roman and Cerezo were in charge of the deal.

To increase or not to increase?

PARIS, Jan 10 (AFP). Bigger balls or not. That is one of the many dilemmas facing table-tennis which is forever experimenting with new ideas. Talk in table tennis circles has it that the usual 38mm ball, used for decades, could be increased to 40 mm in an attempt to make the sport more attractive to watch. With rallies at top level getting shorter and shorter because of the current racket coverings which give so much spin and speed, a bigger ball would slow the game down. Although the idea is not yet to be discussed at the next biennial general meeting (BGM) at the World Championships in Belgrade, the bigger ball issue is likely to return to the ITTF's agenda, according to leading international table-tennis official Ian Marshall from England. "The ball issue is still brewing," Marshall said.

Martin calls for coolness

MELBOURNE, Jan 10 (Reuters/Internet). Australian Open champion Petr Korda kept a low profile on Sunday ahead of what promises to be a trying week as players and officials begin closer scrutiny of his positive steroid test at Wimbledon. While Australian media continued to canvass talk of a player boycott of the Open over the Korda drugs case, former top 10 player Todd Martin counselled moderation until the full circumstances are known. Australian Open officials threw their support behind their deferring champion. "I really prefer not to see such an outcry as a lynching, so to speak," Martin told reporters. Korda tested positive for the banned steroid nandrolone at Wimbledon last year and was stripped of the ranking points he earned plus the \$94,529 prize money he won for reaching the quarterfinals. An International Tennis Federation (ITF) Appeals Committee stopped short of sentencing Korda to the mandatory one-year ban under its own anti-doping rules because it believed he did not knowingly take the drug. However, in the past week several players including Sweden's Jonas Bjorkman and women's number one Lindsay Davenport have expressed concern over the case and the lenient penalty. Korda is likely to be the main topic of conversation at a scheduled ATP meeting in Melbourne on Saturday, which will be attended by many of the players the association represents. Korda, who has kept his thoughts closely guarded since arriving late on Friday night, on Tuesday will face the Australian media for the first time this year. On Monday, the world number 13 will have a practice bout against former number one Andre Agassi. He then plays in the Colonial Classic at Kooyung, a traditional Australian Open warm-up tournament, and will be hoping for a better performance than his first round defeat at the Qatar Open last week.

FESPIC Games start in Bangkok

BANGKOK, Jan 10: Thailand planned to display its rich cultural heritage Sunday evening in lavish ceremonies opening a week-long competition for 2,423 athletes from 34 countries, reports AP. Crown Prince Vajiralongkorn is to represent King Bhumibol Adulyadej in the opening pageantry for the 7th Far East and South Pacific Games for the Disabled, or FESPIC Games. Nearly 10,000 performers were to put on shows symbolizing Thailand's history and equality in one world at the 20,000-seat, Thammasat Rangsit stadium. The Games come three weeks after Thailand hosted the Asian Games and organizers hope the FESPIC Games will be equally successful. It is the first time they will be held in Thailand. The athletes, whose disabilities range from amputation to blindness to mental impairment, will compete in 15 sports for 467 gold medals. Several athletes from Cambodia have lost limbs from mines. The sports are athletics, wheelchair basketball, boccia, badminton, archery, powerlifting, goalball, swimming, wheelchair fencing, judo, table tennis, shooting, wheelchair tennis, volleyball and soccer. Specific handicaps, such as separate 100 meter races for competitors missing legs and those who are blind.
