Eid-ul-Fitr celebrated

The nation on Tuesday celebrated the holy Eid-ul-Fitr amidst mirth, enthusiasm and religious fervour wishing peace, progress and prosperity for the country and greater unity of the world Muslim, reports UNB.

The Eid festivity that heralded the end of month-long fasting was marked by thousands of Eid congregations across the country and exchange of Eid greetings by the Muslims.

Wearing Pajama and Panjabi, Muslim devotees — the rich and the poor — offered their Eid prayers seeking divine blessings for peace and unity of the Muslim Ummah.

In the capital, the main Eid congregation was held at National Eidgah Maidan at 8 am. President Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed attended the prayer. Four Eid congregations were held at Baitul Mukarram National Mosque.

The last Eid congregation in the city was held at Dayemia Shahi Jame-e-Mosque of Chhoti Daira Sharif at 11 am. The biggest Eid congregation was held at Sholkia maidan in Kishoreganj with the participation of some two lakh people.

The President hosted two receptions — one for diplomats and the other for elite at Bangabhaban. He exchanged Eid greetings with the invitees.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina also hosted receptions for diplomats and people from all walks of life at her official residence at Ganobhaban. A large number of people of different strata of the society gathered at Ganobhaban this morning. The Prime Minister exchanged Eid greetings with them.

Opposition leader Begum Khaleda Zia passed a busy day Tuesday exchanging Eid greetings with the public, politicians, diplomats and professionals.

Hasina in her address said the local governments had been strengthened for the welfare of the people and the elected representatives would give leadership in development in their localities, which she hoped would accelerate the development work.

She said Awami League believes in the politics of independence, human rights, the rule of law and, above all, the right to vote and, above all, the right to work.

"We are committed to establishing the rule of law in the country," she said mentioning in this context that the verdict in the killing of Bangabandhu has been delivered and trial of the killing of four national leaders inside jail has begun.

Against the backdrop of such a political scenario of the country, the Prime Minister made a call for those who "do not believe in killings, coup and conspiracy and want to uphold the spirit of Liberation War and democracy" to come forward to work together for the nation's economic emancipation.

Giving Eid greetings to the people of the country on the occasion of the greatest Muslim festival, she also called upon the people to work in unison to build a happy, prosperous and exploitation-free Bangladesh as dreamt by Father of the Nation Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, sinking all differences and imbibing the tenets of holy Ramadan.

Giving a brief resume of various welfare activities of her government Hasina said it successfully tackled history's worst flooding last monsoon at the grace of Almighty Allah. She referred to her visit to Makkah where she sought blessings of the Almighty when the country had been suffering from the unprecedented floods.

The Prime Minister said about three crore people of 70 per cent areas of the country had been affected by the floods. The country has incurred an estimated loss of Tk 10,228 crore in agriculture, industrial and infrastructure sectors.

Hasina recalled that the people and military and civil administrations had worked shoulder to shoulder to face the calamity.

"Many aired fears that two crore people would die of starvation and post-flood diseases. But with the grace of Allah, the flood losses have been minimised," she said.

The Prime Minister said the government had distributed 62,000 metric tonnes of food as grants till December. Another 2.40 lakh MT foodgrain was distributed among the poor families on 42.52 lakh VGF cards.

Obituary

General Manager of Bangladesh Bank ASM Tofazzal Hossain died of cardiac failure in the city on Thursday. He was 49, reports UNB.

Hossain, who hailed from Gabtoli, Bogra, has left behind his wife, three daughters.

Tofazzal Hossain was a front-ranking freedom fighter during the Liberation War.

His quikhwani will be held at his residence at Bangladesh Bank quarters, Banani, after Magreb prayers tomorrow.

Meanwhile, Photo Journalists Forum president Pavel Rahman and general secretary Azizur Rahman Peu expressed condolence at the death of Nur Alam.

PM meets people

People of all walks of life — men, women and children on Tuesday exchanged Eid greetings with Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina at her Ganobhaban official residence, reports BSS.

The gigantic iron gate at the main entrance of Ganobhaban remained opened for all citizens of the republic who reached their beloved leader to say 'Eid Mubarak' without facing any kind of security barrier or protocol.

People in one file queued at the Ganobhaban vast yard beginning from Mirpur road in the west and ending at Prime Minister's portico where Sheikh Hasina in her traditional Jamdani saree stood hours together exchanging greetings with the visitors.

She received the common people from 9 am to 10 am, the diplomats from 10 am to 11 am and again the common people from 11 am to 12 noon. She also received thousands of people between 3 pm to 4-30 pm in the same venue.

Those who came to the sprawling green of Ganobhaban in the shiny winter morning and afternoon included minister to office peon, law makers to litigants, millionaires to beggars, city mayors to street cleaners, university vice-chancellors to primary school students, housewives to garments workers.

and representatives of Dhaka-based foreign missions and international organisations, journalists, intellectuals and government officials.

The BNP chairperson and Leader of the Opposition exchanged pleasantries with them either at her 29 Minto Road official residence or her cantonment residence.
