Attack on poet Shamsur Rahman condemned

More socio-political organisations and individuals including Mayor Hanif yesterday condemned the attack on leading poet Shamsur Rahman and urged the pro-liberation forces to unitedly resist such heinous attack, reports BSS.

In a statement, Hanif termed the attempt on the life of the poet as an attack on "democratic values and free-thinking" and demanded exemplary punishment of the persons responsible.

In a joint statement, 11 religious leaders protested the attack, saying a certain quarter was preaching the mantra of "violence and terrorism" in the name of Islam for their vested interest.

They also expressed concern at the report that the several other leading intellectuals including the Director General of Islamic Foundation Maulana Abdul Awal was on the "hit list" of the extremist forces.

The signatories to the statement included Maulana Wahiduzzaman, Maulana Abu Sufian, Maulana Ruhul Amin Siraji, and Maulana Zakir Hossain.

Eighty-seven Dhaka University teachers in a statement, said they were "aggrieved, shocked and feared" to know that the extremist group's plan was to stage another December 14 in the country.

The signatories included Prof Sultana Shahi, Prof Shahadat Ali, Dr Ranglal Sen, Sheikh Abdus Salam, Abdul Mannan Chowdhury, Durgadas Bhattacharya, and Mridul Kanti Chakrabarty.

The officers and employees

of Islamic Foundation yesterday staged a protest rally to condemn the conspiracy to kill the intellectuals.

They said the attempt was an effort to deliberately undermine the Islamic ideals of welfare and peace.

Bangladesh Mujibnagar Karnachari Kalyan Sangsad in a statement described the incident as an attack on the spirit of the Liberation War and demanded stern action against the anti-liberation forces.

In a joint statement, Pahari Chhatra Parishad, Pahari Cano Parishad and Hill Women's Federation expressed their concern at the incident and demanded punishment of those responsible.

Meanwhile, Nagarik Pro-tirodh Committee will stage a protest rally at the Central Shaheed Minar at 3 pm today. Prof Kabir Chowdhury will chair the rally to be followed by a protest march.

Home minister visits Shamsur Rahman

Home Minister Rafiqul Islam yesterday visited poet Shamsur Rahman at his Shaymoli residence, reports BSS.

The minister assured the poet of safety and security. Steps have already been taken for proper investigation into the attack, the minister said. Additional Inspector General of Police (CID) Mohammad Nurul Huda and other officials of the department accompanied the minister.

FEMA for political reconciliation before municipal elections

A meeting of the national committee of the Fair Election Monitoring Alliance (FEMA) yesterday expressed deep concern at the projected opposition boycott of the forthcoming municipal polls and urged the political parties to resolve their differences through dialogue, and by taking practical measures, says a press release.

It also stressed the need for contested and meaningful polls — a universally accepted principle of pluralist democracy. Ambassador Abul Ahsan, Acting Chairperson of FEMA, said, "Elections are only a means to an end. The end in this case being the emergence of representative urban local government taking charge of the affairs of their respective locality."

The alliance also urged the government to initiate a dialogue with the opposition to facilitate their participation in the polls. It observed that though the municipal polls are not held on party basis it is generally the leaders of the political parties that contest the elections. In the absence of participation of opposition political parties the choice of the electorates becomes limited and the polls lack credibility.

The meeting further held that the Election Commission must not only be seen to act independently but must be perceived to be non-partisan in order to enhance its credibility.

Abul Ahsan said that in a situation of political confrontation, ordinary citizens become captives to the contenders of political powers. All efforts should therefore, be directed towards political reconciliation paving the way to participatory elections, he added.

UN envoy meets Noor Uddin

US Ambassador in Dhaka John C Holzman met with Science and Technology Minister Muhammad Noor Uddin Khan at his office yesterday, reports UNB.

During the hour-long meeting, they discussed matters relating to mutual interests with special emphasis on cooperation and support in the field of science and technology of Bangladesh.

Economic and Commercial officer of US Embassy L Farsyth accompanied the Ambassador.

Daughter not allowed to visit Obaidur Rahman

Professor Shaheda Obaed, wife of BNP leader KM Obaidur Rahman, in a statement yesterday said their only daughter was not allowed to visit her father, now detained at the prison cell of PG hospital, before her departure for the United States.

She said their daughter Shama Islam and her husband Shovon Islam who work in California wanted to visit Obaidur Rahman before their return to their work on January 25 on humanitarian ground as they were not certain how long it would take for their next visit.

But the prison authorities declined to entertain their plea. Mrs Obaed said.

Earlier on Eid day, the family members of Obaidur Rahman were allowed to visit him on a court order.

Navy seizes two mechanised boats

Bangladesh navy ship Tanveen during its routine patrol seized two wooden bodied mechanised boats with 310 tonnes of foreign salt and arrested 19 crew of the boats near Sandweep yesterday, said an ISPR press release, reports BSS.

The total value of the goods, including boats, is about Taka 61 lakh 50 thousands.

Goods, boats and crew were later handed over to the proper authority for legal action.

SWAA annual reunion Feb 12

The eighth annual reunion of Social Welfare Alumni Association (SWAA) will be held at Mouchak holiday resort at Gazipur on February 12, a SWAA press release said yesterday, reports BSS.
