World Heritage Site

PM to unveil plaque Feb 4

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina is expected to unveil the plaque of World Heritage Site at the Sundarbans on February 4 instead of January 31, reports BSS.

The programme has been rescheduled in view of the Biswa Ujtema at Tongi. The plaque will be unveiled at Hiron Point.

The decision was taken at an inter-ministerial meeting held yesterday with Minister for Forests and Environment Sajeda Chowdhury in the chair.

Officials said nearly 139700 hectares of forest area will be brought under the world heritage site.

Foreign assistance is likely to come for necessary infrastructural development to build the world heritage site as an appropriate location of ecotourism, besides ensuring the safety of the forest and conservation of its resources.

The meeting discussed the activities of different ministries and organisations engaged in the overall management of the plaque-unveiling ceremony. The conservation and development of the forest, which will begin through coordinated efforts, will be maintained at any cost, the meeting was told.

20 injured in bus-tempo collision

At least 20 people, including a child and a woman, were injured when a bus and a tempo collided head-on on the Dhaka-Mawa highway in Keraniganj thana area yesterday. Fourteen of them were admitted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital. The ten injured were identified as Husne Ara, 2, Jayeda Begum, 50, Ali Hossain, 26, Sheikh Chumnu, 55, Sheikh Siraz, 27, Momtaz, 20, Kader, 25, Nizam, 30, Sujan, 15, and Kajal, 50. The four others could not be identified immediately. According to police, the Dhaka-bound bus and the tempo coming from the opposite direction collided at Mollarkul at around 9:30 am. The bus also skidded off the road and hit a tree. Police seized both the vehicles. But the bus driver and the helpers escaped from the scene.
