Over 70 thousand housing units to be constructed for homeless

The government has decided to construct 73,375 housing units for the rural homeless people under the 'Housing Fund' programme, reports BSS.

The Taka 58 crore 'housing fund' is first of its kind in the country to provide loan to the rural people with abject poverty for construction of dwelling houses.

In the first phase, 30 non-governmental organisations will construct 10,200 houses at a cost of Tk 20.40 crore. The NGOs will also be entrusted with the responsibility of loan recovery.

The third meeting of the Housing Fund Trustee Board approved this yesterday. Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina was in the chair.

The meeting also directed the authorities to start disbursement of money immediately.

The Prime Minister also approved the two crore grant for building houses for the poor people of the hill districts of Rangamati, Khagrachari and Bandarban. Besides, another Tk five crore was sanctioned from this fund for implementation of 'Ashrayan Prokalpa' under which 3,500 poor people have already been given shelters.

Explaining the activities of the Trustee Board, Finance Minister Shah A M S Kibria said this programme, a milestone in social safety network, was initiated under the dynamic leadership of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina.

He said housing loans of various types have so far been given to the well-to-do section of the urban people and no previous governments thought of the housing facilities for the vast poor rural masses.

The Prime Minister announced in the meeting that all the distressed and homeless people would be provided with housing facilities in phases.

She said this programme will generate a deep sense of self-confidence among the homeless poor.

Member-secretary of the trust and Deputy Governor of Bangladesh Bank Ataur Huq, while presenting the agenda, informed the meeting that 854 NGOs had submitted application to implement the programme. After strict scrutiny by a sub-committee headed by the finance minister, 30 organisations were selected.

In the first phase of the programme, 100 such houses would be constructed in each thana.

The meeting observed that so far, the NGOs received fund for their various welfare activities from foreign donors.

15-yr master plan for construction of deep sea port

CHITTAGONG, Feb 9: A 15-year master plan has been prepared for construction of a deep sea port in Chittagong and the plan has already been approved by the special evaluation committee of the National Planning Commission, reports BSS.

Chittagong City Development Coordination Committee at a meeting this morning approved the decision for construction of the deep sea port.

Presided over by City Corporation Mayor ABM Mohiuddin Chowdhury, the meeting discussed the importance of a deep sea port in Chittagong in view of its geographical location and the growing demand for its international use.

A technical assistance project proposal has also been sent to the government for feasibility study.

The authorities have been seeking financial and technical assistance from donors and the friendly countries to help construct the deep sea port.

The meeting was attended, among others, by Chittagong WASA Chairman Sultan Mahmud Chowdhury, Chittagong Port Authority Chairman Capt Zahir Uddin Mahmud, CDA Chairman MM KZ Jalalbadhi, CMP Commissioner AT Ahmedul Huq Chowdhury, Bangladesh Railway (East Zone) General Manager ATM Nurul Islam and Deputy Commissioner of Chittagong Muhammad Hasan.



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
