'No scope to grab power through undemocratic ways'

Forest and Environment Minister Syeda Sajeda Chowdhury yesterday said the opposition's decision to boycott the municipal elections is nothing but an expression of no-confidence to the people's verdict, reports UNB.

Addressing a public meeting at Ramkantapur Bazar in Nargarkanda thana in Faridpur, she said there is no scope to grab power through adopting undemocratic ways without having people's support or in collusion with the evil forces.

Sajeda said people would unitedly resist any effort to prevent them from exercising their right to franchise by calling hartals.

She called upon all, irrespective of their political affiliations, to declare their areas as 'hartal-free' for the interest of development and prosperity.

About 2,000 leaders and workers of BNP of Aftab union joined Awami League expressing their solidarity with the ideals of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Rahman and activities of the present government.

On Tuesday at a meeting to review the progress of ongoing projects, the minister asked the concerned officials to work hard for implementing various uplift projects, including Ashrafi, tree plantation and old-age allowances proper.

Fast-unto-death

8 former bank employees fall sick

Eight former employees of different banks, observing a hunger strike with others in front of the Central Shaheed Minar, fell sick yesterday, reports BSS.

The bank employees who were dismissed from their services in 1981 began a fast-unto-death four days back, demanding their reinstatement.

Those who fell sick were identified as Golam Mostafa, Abu Bakar, Haroon-ur-Rashid, Elahi Shah, Musafek, Abdul Hakim, Golam Mustafa and Abdul Hakim. They were admitted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital.

He said that such a meeting could help create a congenial atmosphere for holding the elections peacefully.

Menon in his statement pointed out that under Article 126 of the Constitution, it was the government's constitutional responsibility to extend all cooperation to the Election Commission.

He was critical of the government's approach in confronting the opposition parties, as a result of which, he said, the Election Commission's opportunity to discharge its responsibility became limited.

Under such circumstances, the Workers' Party leader pointed out, it would not be possible for the people to exercise their right to vote.

He further warned that the Workers' Party would not join any voterless election or allow repetition of any election of 'vote dacoity'.

He said that both the government and the opposition parties were trying to use the Election Commission for achieving their narrow self-interest.

Menon also condemned the killing of an opposition party worker on Tuesday and physical assault on opposition leaders and workers including BNP leader Sadek Hossain Khoka.



