**Water Resources Minister says Several pilot projects being implemented under FAP**

Water Resources Minister Abdur Razzak yesterday said the government adopted the Flood Action Plan (FAP), with assistance from the World Bank and UNDP, following the disastrous floods of 1987 and 1988, reports BSS.

At present, the activities of FAP have been integrated with the Water Resources Planning Organisation (WARPO), he said while replying to a question from Haji Mohammad Selim of Awami League at the Jatiya Sangsad yesterday.

The minister said the Flood Action Plan with 26 components — 11 basic and 15 auxiliary — had provision for both direct and indirect measures for flood control in Bangladesh. As per the direct flood control measures under FAP, he said, Bangladesh has been divided into five regions — north-east, north-west, north-mid, south-east and south-west regions. The Dhaka city flood protection project is also included in the direct measures of the FAP, he said. Meanwhile, the indirect measures include facing flood and flood-related damage, which is being funded by donors, he added.

The minister also said several pilot projects, including river training and river survey, were now being implemented under FAP 20, 21, 22 and 24 components.

Replying to a supplementary question from Haji Mohammad Selim, Razzak said the government would take up a project to build a road-cum-embankment in the eastern part of Dhaka city following completion of the ongoing Dhaka city protection embankment. "We will then take up the Kamrangir Char protection project," he said.

Replying to supplementaries from A H M Mostafa Kamal of Awami League, Hafizuddin Ahmed of BNP, Fazley Rabbi of JP and Alamgir Mohammad Mahfuzullah Farid of BNP, the minister said the government would take up projects for protection of Maheshkhali and Kutubdia islands, re-excavation of Dakatia river, and excavation of canals in near future.

Replying to a question from Sheikh Nurul Huq of Awami League from Khulna, the minister said the government has taken up protection measures with bricks and boulders as well as afforestation to save embankments in the coastal belt from tidal surges.

The ongoing second phase of the coastal embankment rehabilitation project and the second coastal embankment rehabilitation project have also embodied the same measures, he

told the House.

Replying to a question from BNP legislator Ziaul Huq Zia from Lakkhipur, the minister said nearly 3000 km of embankments and cross dams under the Water Development Board were damaged by the recent floods.

Of the damaged embankments under 441 projects and sub-projects, 925 km are being rehabilitated with assistance from the Asian Development Bank, World Bank, World Food Programme and the government, he said.

"We are communicating with the donors for rehabilitation of the remaining 2075 km damaged embankments," he said.

Replying to another question from Khairul Enam of BNP from Lakkhipur, Razzak said 24 projects and 20 sub-projects were set to complete during the current fiscal year under the Water Development Board.

Of them, the Meghna estuary study project has already been completed, while the others are being implemented for completion within the stipulated period, he said.

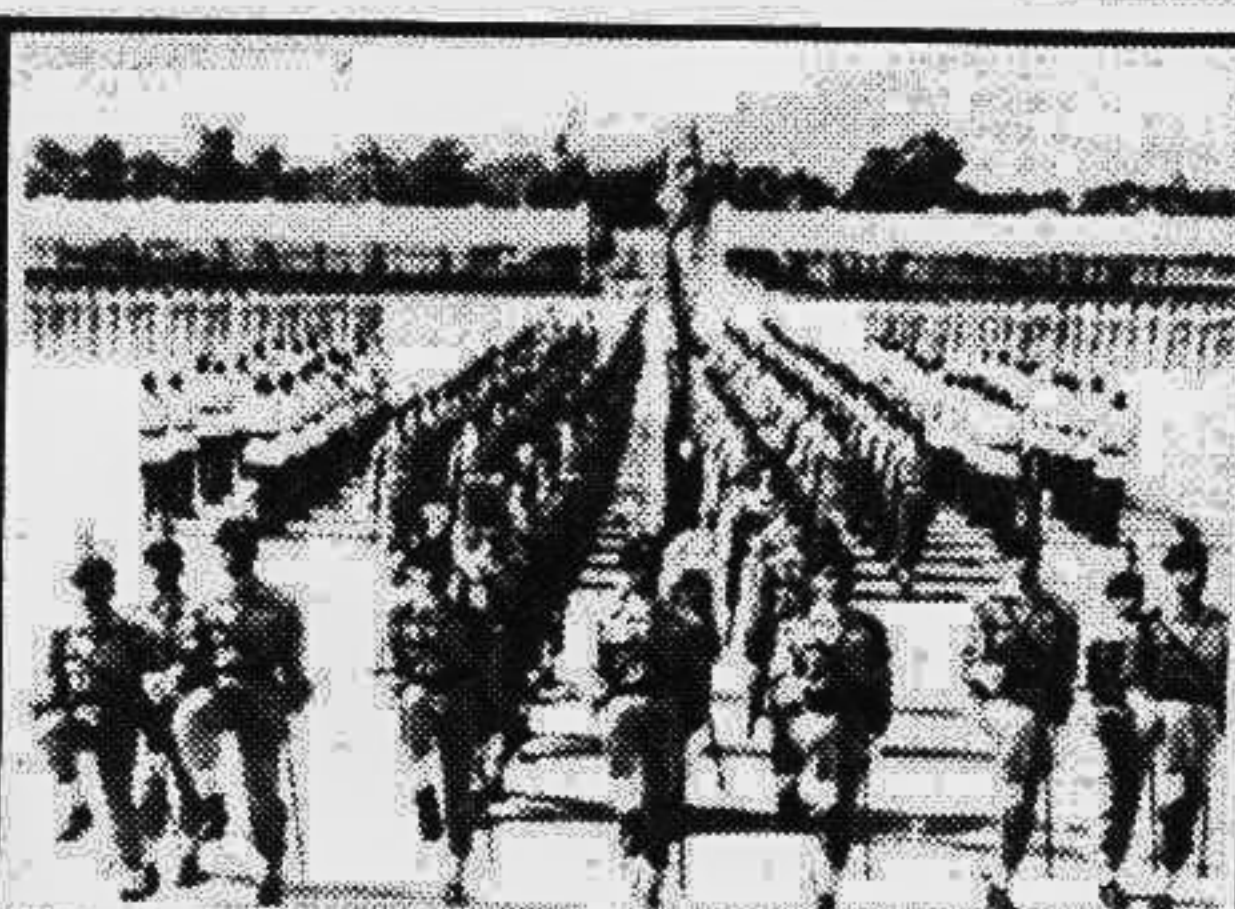
They discussed matters of mutual interests.
