Letter of Order

Senior Scientific Officer of Bangladesh Rice Research Institute RFS Division Dr Md Nazrul Islam was granted deputation vide BRRRI Memo No T-208-88/147 (15) dated 11.1.93 for higher study at University of Kagoshima, Japan from 26.1.93 to 25.1.97.

Dr. Nazrul Islam, vide a letter on 15.1.97 from Japan applied for extending the limit of deputation up to 31.3.97. In respect of that it was requested to send professor's recommendation in favour of extending deputation & financing guarantee letter. But he did not give any reply of that letter. His Professor Dr Tsuyoshi Horiguchi has informed vide his letter dated 28.8.87 that he (Dr Islam) after completion of PhD degree had left for Australia. As such he was sent instruction, vide Memo No IP-980/4526 dt 17.11.97 to his Australian address to join BRRRI work within 21 (twenty-one) days. It was mentioned in the letter that if he failed to join, legal action will be taken against him as per service rules.

Later on he was instructed, vide BRRRI Memo No IP-980/733 dt 22.2.98, to join work with satisfactory explanation for unauthorised absence within 15 (fifteen) days of publication of the notice in newspaper. The notice was published in the Sangbad on 12.3.98. This time also he did not join work nor contacted BRRRI authorities.

Then, vide BRRRI Memo No IP-980/5285 dt 6.12.98 he was accused and chargesheeted for the offence of absconding & misconduct as per Rules 39 (B) (C) of BRRRI Regulations. The chargesheet was sent to all addresses provided by Mr Nazrul Islam at BRRRI & was also published in the Bangladesh Observer on 22.12.98. Mr Nazrul Islam has not given any reply to the chargesheet nor joined BRRRI work.

Under the circumstances, Mr. Nazrul Islam being failed to join BRRRI work & not replying on accusations, is removed from service of the Institute as per Rules 2 (f) & 39 (B) (C) of BRRRI Regulations for the offence of misconduct & absconding.
