**Bangladesh made member of UNEP committee**

Bangladesh has been nominated as a member on the high-powered ministerial and officials-level committee of the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP), reports APB.  
Thirty-five other countries are also on the committee for a two-year period (1999-2001).  
The decision was taken at the 11th meeting of the governing council of UNEP in the Kenyan capital of Nairobi on February 5.  
In a message on Thursday, Executive Director of UNEP Klaus Topfer informed Forest and Environment Minister Syeda Sajeda Chowdhury of the decision, an official release said yesterday.  
As an associate organisation of the United Nations, the committee will help and assist the executive council of UNEP in formulating and implementing the world environment development programmes.  
The other members of the committee include Japan, Germany, France, China, Canada, Switzerland and India.

**Police lack equipment, men in fighting outlaws: IGP**

Police have no additional forces, nor the requisite equipment, to conduct special drives against the outlawed terrorists in the country's southern region, reports UNB.  
"The reported 'special drives' were not at all something, special as the police are not equipped properly to launch such operations," Inspector General of Police AYBI Siddiqui told the journalists on Thursday.  
Talking to the press ahead of the police rally on March 8-11, he explained the overall situation of the police force and the problems they are facing.  
Siddiqui said to tackle the situation in the southern parts by conducting special drives against the outlaws, it will need continuous operation with huge forces by setting up permanent camps in the troubled areas.  
"However, until special arrangements can be made, we are trying to improve the situation by conducting drives with limited logistic support," he said.  
The IGP said that a long-term special operation was needed to deal with the long-standing problem of terrorism in the southern parts of the country.  
In 1998, murder and rape cases increased across the country with murder incidents rising alarmingly in the southern region with the increasing activities of the outlawed groups.  
He said last year, at least 121 murder cases were filed in the south-western region accusing the outlawed terrorists.  
Giving a break-up, Siddiqui informed that 40 cases were filed in different thanas of Kushtha district, 30 in Chuadanga district, 20 in Jhenidah district, 15 in Khulna district, 7 in Jessore district, 6 in Meherpur district and 2 in KMP area.  
The IGP said some steps have been taken to improve the law and other situation, especially in a bid to curb the recent activities of the outlaws in the southern region.  
Already, 10 investigators of the CID police, led by a superintendent of police, have been directed to probe into some sensational cases in different thanas of Khulna region.  
They will investigate the cases, staying in Khulna, so that action can be taken against the accused persons as quickly as possible, the IGP said.  
He added that the special branch of police has also been asked to collect more information about the outlaws operating in the area.
