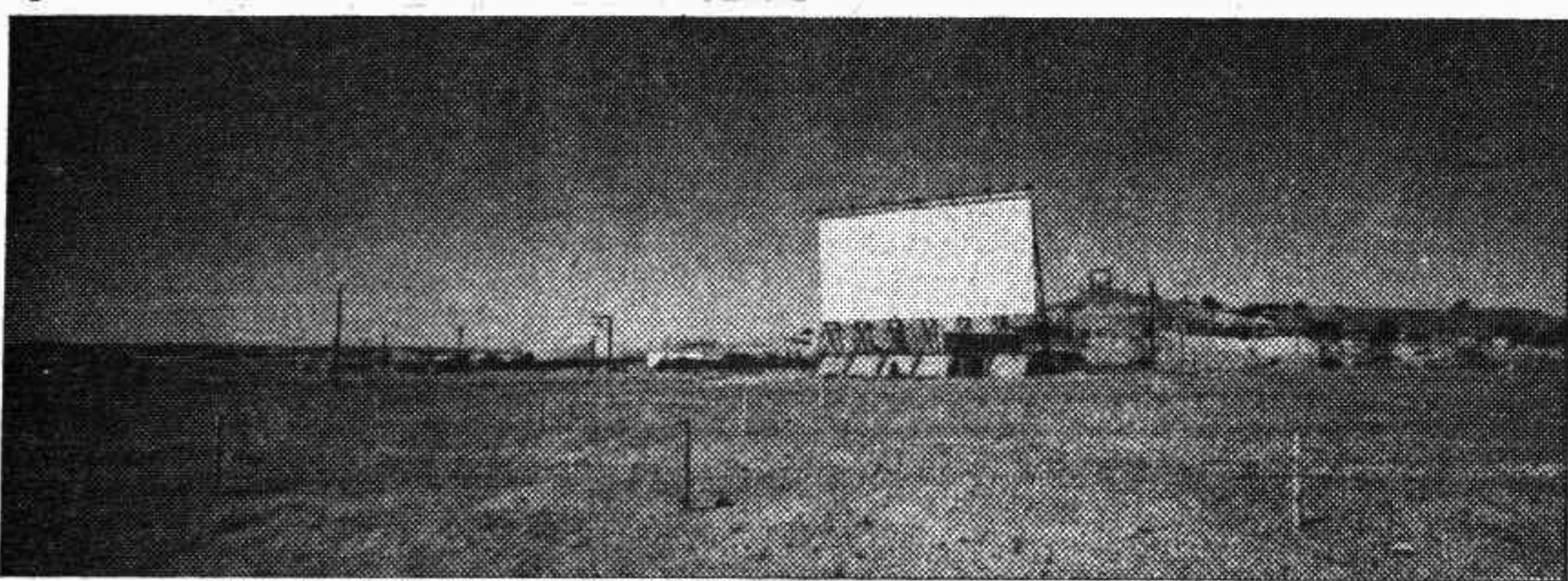

Wim Wender's Quest for Signs not Symbols

Great German film-maker Wim Wenders' 6-day long retrospective opens today at Goethe Institut Dhaka.

EVEN today, despite films like "All Rivers Run" and "East of Eden" shown on MTV and earlier films like "Mutiny on the Bounty", we in the subcontinent, have still have to know much about the beauty and serenity of the continent of Australia. This is especially so in the subcontinent and for the average citizen in Dhaka. Wim Wender's series of films and his photographic exhibition which will be inaugurated at the Goethe Institut today, will provide in-depth analysis of not only Germany but also cities of Australia which,

grated or simply disappeared, without leaving enough traces. What one can track are metal fences, pipes, trucks, caravans, a reject-cars heap and masses of corrugated iron sheets. A single shot depicts a city life with

almost haunted lit-up office rooms.

Born in Dusseldorf, Germany in '45, Wenders studied at the Munich College of Television and Film from '67 to '70. He wrote reviews for Filmkritik and "Suddeutsche Zeitung". He has won many national and international awards for his film direction such as that for "Ribbon in Gold" for "The American Friend" '78, "Paris, Texas", '83 (Film Ribbon in Gold), "The State of Things" for which he won "The Golden Lion" at the Venice Film Festival in '82, the "Palme d'Or" at the Cannes Film Festival in '87 for "Paris, Texas" and the '88 "European Film Prize" for "Wings of Desire".

"Summer in the City" is about a misfit, Hans, who haunted by his past, becomes a vagabond travelling to places like Munich, New York and Amsterdam. This film portrays the lack of hospitality in the big cities and the futility and is appointment in the pointless moments of flights. This will be screened today at 6 pm.

"The Goalkeeper's Fear of the Penalty" is about the vicissitudes of life of a goalkeeper Josef Bloch, who insults the referee, follows a girl from the cinema, kills her for no apparent purpose, and gets away scot-free despite the news flash in the papers about the murder. This will be screened on 15th

March at 5 pm.

"Alice in the Cities" is about a journalist, Philip Winter, who wants to return to Germany after his assignment is over. Due to an air-strike the hero is compelled to stay at Lisa's in Amsterdam, and they wait for Alice to join them. The film tells the story of the quest for self-identity, and the friendship that develops between Philip and Alice. This will be screened the same day at 7 pm.

"Wrong Move" has young Wilhelm Meister, a modern-times film descendent of Goethe's hero. This tale of adventure brings in a Nazi officer and the death of a Jew, along with another killing in a fit of temper by Meister. The last scene brings in the hero still determined to be a famous writer. This will be screened on 16th March at 5 pm.

"Kings of the Road", screened at 7 pm, the same day, has the story of two heroes whose everyday lives are delineated with humour and sympathy.

"The American Friend" with its adoption of Patricia Highsmith's novel "Ripley's Game" bringing together the talents of actors and directors from USA, breaks the rules of film-making, to create what the director believes to be a cinema full of both love and hate. This will be screened on 18th March at 5 pm.

"Until the End of the World" which is based in '99, and depicts a world at the edge of total chaos, brings a adventures that take the protagonists to the ends of the earth. This will be shown on the same day at 7 pm.

"Lisbon Story" screened on 19th March, the film opens up with a strange cryptic postcard. It deals with the film world and romantic notions of filming including the use of the microphone and hand-cranking camera as seen used by Buster Keaton in "Cameraman". The film processes begin in Lisbon and so the choice of the title.

"Paris Texas", to be screened at 7 pm on the same day, deals with the return of an individual Travis, who goes back to Texas, to make up with his wife and child, and gradually, he gets back his lost identity. This is an unusual and unique story to mark Wender's best achievement.
