Veteran freedom fighter, so-
cial worker and politician and
newly-elected chairman of
Kabirhat Pourashava Haji Mo-
hammad Idris died at his
Noakhali residence Friday
night. He was 83, reports BSS.

Idris was also president of
the advisory committee of
Noakhali district of Awami
League.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina
has expressed her deep
sorrow at the death of Haji Idris.

In a message of condolence
she described late Idris as a dedi-
cated Awami League leader
who worked relentlessly for the
welfare of the people. He was
also a close associate of father
of the nation Bangabandhu
Sheikh Mujibur Rahman.

The Prime Minister ex-
pressed his sympathy for the
members of the bereaved family
and prayed for the peace of the
departed soul.

JHALAKATHI, Mar 20: Ad-
vocate Atahar Uddin Sikder,
president of district units of Na-
tional Awami Party (NAP),
Udichi Shilpi Gosthi and
Democratic Lawyers' Associa-
tion, died here on Thursday. He
was 70, reports APP.

He left behind his wife, three
sons, five daughters, and a host
of friends and relatives to
mourn his death.

He was buried at the family
graveyard at Manpasha village
in the Sadar thana following
namz-e-janaza in front of the
Jhalakathi District Bar Asso-
ciation.

International Day for the
Elimination of Racial Discrim-
ination will be observed in the
country as elsewhere in the globe

The day is being observed
since proclamation of the day
by the United Nations General
Assembly in its 1966 session.
This year, the day is being
memorised in the midst of the
Third Decade (1993-2003).

On this day in 1960, police
opened fire and killed 69 people
at a peaceful demonstration in
Sharpeville of South Africa
against the apartheid "pass
laws."

To mark the day, President
Shahabuddin Ahmed and
Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina
gave separate messages reiterat-
ing the country's unequivocal
support to the efforts of the
United Nations and the Interna-
tional Community towards
building a just and equitable
world.

Prime Minister Sheikh
Hasina in her message, recalled
the progress achieved towards
the implementation of the ob-
jectives of the declaration since
the UN proclamation, in 1966
and the International convention
in 1969 and during the
Third UN Decade.

12 houses gutted
