JU admission tests
by June likely

First year honours admission tests under the 1998-99 session of Jahangirnagar University (JU) is likely to be held by June this year.

JU Central Admission Committee at a meeting recently finalised the tentative period for holding the exams. The decision came against the backdrop of previous years' late holding of admission tests which led to beginning of classes some 18 months behind the schedule.

In a desperate bid to reduce time in completing the admission procedure, the customary viva voce exam for all departments except for admission into Drama and Dramatics Department have been abolished.

A total of 809 students will be enrolled this year under 24 departments. Out of this, 445 male and 217 female students will be enrolled from the merit list, 12 under player's quota, 15 under tribal quota, 48 under freedom-fighters' ward quota and 72 under the quota for teachers and employees' wards.

Students will be allowed to answer questions of maximum four subjects under 'Ka' (Science) and 'Ga' (Arts) units and three subjects in 'Kha' (Social Science) and 'Gha' (Biological Sciences) unit in the admission test.

Application forms of 'Ka' and 'Ga' units will be available for Tk 150 while those of 'Kha' and 'Gha' for Tk 125. The forms will be available from March 18 to April 9 from Agrani Bank's branches at Jahangirnagar University, New Market, Farmgate, Mirpur and National Museum.

Although four new departments - International Relations, Environmental Science, Rural and Urban Planning and Biochemistry and Molecular Biology, have been introduced this year, a lesser number of students will be enrolled this year due to accommodation problem in the residential halls. The lone full fledged residential university of the country enrolls students as per the vacant seats in its dormitories.

Registrar Mohammad Ali Meteorological Day today
