JU admission tests by June likely

First year honours admission tests under the 1998-99 session of Jahangirnagar University (JU) is likely to be held by June this year.

JU Central Admission Committee at a meeting recently finalised the tentative period for holding the exams. The decision came against the backdrop of previous years' late holding of admission tests which led to beginning of classes some 18 months behind the schedule.

In a desperate bid to reduce time in completing the admission procedure, the customary viva voce exam for all departments except for admission into Drama and Dramatics Department have been abolished.

A total of 809 students will be enrolled this year under 24 departments. Out of this, 445 male and 217 female students will be enrolled from the merit list, 12 under player's quota, 15 under tribal quota, 48 under freedom-fighters' ward quota and 72 under the quota for teachers and employees' wards. Students will be allowed to answer questions of maximum four subjects under 'Ka' (Science) and 'Ga' (Arts) units and three subjects in 'Kha' (Social Science) and 'Gha' (Biological Sciences) unit in the admission test.

Application forms of 'Ka' and 'Ga' units will be available for Tk 150 while those of 'Kha' and 'Gha' for Tk 125. The forms will be available from March 18 to April 9 from Agrani Bank's branches at Jahangirnagar University, New Market, Farmgate, Mirpur and National Museum.

Although four new departments - International Relations, Environmental Science, Rural and Urban Planning and Biochemistry and Molecular Biology, have been introduced this year, a lesser number of students will be enrolled this year due to accommodation problem in the residential halls. The lone full fledged residential university of the country enrolls students as per the vacant seats in its dormitories.

National dailies will bring out special supplement on the occasion. Meanwhile, exhibition of meteorological equipments and charts will also be held at Meteorological and Geophysical Centre at Agrabad, Chittagong.

Advertisement Requesting Expression of Interest (EOI) for Research Works

The Urban Primary Health Care Project (UPHCP), under Local Government Division of Ministry of Local Government, Rural Development & Co-operative Government of Bangladesh is requesting letters expressing interest from Bangladeshi institutions interested to conduct research in the following areas:

1. Effectiveness trial of Rotavirus Vaccine
2. Effectiveness trial of Haemophilus Influenzae B (Hib) vaccine
3. Community-based safe motherhood services
4. Improved Weaning Practices
5. Improved Hygiene Education
6. Other issues in Urban Health, e.g. reproductive tract infection, violence against women.

Institutions can submit EOI for one or more of the research areas. However, separate EOI needs to be submitted for each topic. The following information will have to be provided in an EOI which can not exceed more than 10 pages.

1. Nature of organization
2. Number of technical experts available in the institution
3. Working relationship with MOHFW and DGHS/DGFP
4. Working relationship with other UN agencies (State concrete Examples)
5. Institutions dissemination and publication track record in the relevant field
6. Access to study population in and outside Dhaka
7. Availability of computer/data analysis services
8. Management structure to support, supervise and monitor field studies
9. Availability of other support services including financial and personnel management systems, communication, office space, vehicles etc.

The following additional information will have to be provided by institutions interested in vaccine research.

1. In-house investigators with skills in epidemiology, micrology, immunology, clinical sciences, health economics and social science.
2. Demonstrated ability to set up large scale surveillance and handle large data sets.
3. Availability of in-house microbiology, virology and immunology laboratories needed for rotavirus and Hib trial.
