Higher oil prices unlikely to have severe impact on Asia

SINGAPORE, Mar 23: Deflation at home will minimise the impact of higher oil prices on crisis-hit Asian economies, analysts said here, as OPEC oil ministers prepared to ratify an agreement to cut production, reports AFP.

"The inflationary impact of the higher oil prices in Asia will be less severe than in the past, given substantial domestic deflationary pressures," said Chan Chai Lin of ABN Amro's Asian Economic Research Unit in Singapore.

Alingering depression in consumer demand in the region, along with a moderation of economic growth will cushion any negative impact of higher crude prices, Chan said, despite the rise in oil prices by more than 30 per cent in the last few weeks.

In the world's second largest economy, Japan, which has

been mired in a recession for almost a decade, "oil distributors see less demand as users in the heavy machinery industry are burdened with excess capacity, said Keiko Sasaki, analyst at Ing Barings in Tokyo.

Huge current account surpluses chalked up by regional economies would also absorb the shock of higher oil prices on countries' balance of payments. analysts said.

If the benchmark Brent Crude price averages 13 to 14 US dollars per barrel in 1999, inflation in the region is expected to be "at worst" half a per cent to seven-tenths of a per cent higher than original estimates. ABN Amro said.

Oil ministers of member countries of the Organisation of Petroleum Exporting Countries (OPEC) were to meet in Vienna Tuesday to ratify and agreement to cut output by some two million barrels a day to bolster prices.

Seven of the 11 OPEC members have already confirmed publicly the level of cuts they intend to implement from April following agreement reached between OPEC and non-OPEC oil producers earlier this

month. Saudi Arabia, the world's largest oil producer, has been leading the effort to boost oil prices as its own and other oildependent economies ran into budget problems with no sign of an upturn in demand that would boost prices from closer to their historic low levels.

Of the hardest hit Asian cri-' sis economies that export oil, Indonesia, and OPEC member and Malaysia, a non-member of the Vienna-based body are expected to benefit from the higher crude prices following the production cuts.

Thai govt wants to cut salaries, trim bureaucracy

BANGKOK, Mar 23: Faced with declining revenues and spiraling costs, Thailand's government wants to cut bureaucrats' salaries and eventually trim their ranks, the government said on Tuesday, reports

Prime Minister Chuan Leekpai, meanwhile, admitted that Thailand's recession was causing pain and hardship, particu-larly for people in rural areas.

"If any leader could now think everything is fine, he is no leader", Chuan was quoted as saying by the Bangkok Post.

Akaphol Sorasuchart, a spokesman for the government, said government salaries were eating up more than 50 per cent of Thailand's budget.

"It should not be more than 40 per cent," he said. "In the short term, we would like to cut salaries. In the long term, we would like to reduce the number of government officials, to restructure the government."

He gave no specific targets for the reductions. Thailand is in the midst of its worst economic crisis in modern times and is receiving a \$ 17.2 billion bailout from the

land's currency will weaken slightly over the next few months before stabilising as the economy begins to recover. several economists said Tuesday, reports AP.

But a few bearish forecasters warn the currency's slide could accelerate if the expected recovery doesn't materialise soon.

Thailand, battling its worst economic crisis in modern time, was forced to turn to the International Monetary Fund tor a \$17.2 billion bailout after the value of its currency, the baht, plummeted in 1997.

The crisis was set off when Thailand floated the baht in July of that year. The currency dropped as low as about 57 baht to the dollar but has since rebounded to around 37.5 baht.

Many observers say the Thai currency will likely drift lower to about 40 baht to the dollar by the end of this year. It should stabilise at that level as Thailand's economy starts to grow, they say.

The nation's economy contracted about 7 per cent in 1998. but the government predicts I per cent growth for this year.

prices. "Recovery hopes in Thailand need to be reassessed. Deflation will hamper recovery since in a climate of falling prices, the incentive for fresh consumption and investment falls," Supple

He also warned the disappointing results of last Friday's bad-debt auction could signal further trouble alread.

The Financial Sector Restructuring Authority, or FRA, raised just 18 cents on the dollar at an auction of 220 billion baht (\$5.86 billion) worth of loans from closed finance companies.

"With more asset sales expected over the coming years the banking system, further asset deflation appears likely," Supple said.

But other analysts say recent legislative achievements by Prime Minister Chuan Leekpai's coalition government, international aid and a new economic stimulus package due to be announced on March 30 have given the country a chance of escaping a deflationary spiral.

That would probably led to just a moderate decline in the

Deputy Premier Supachai Panitchpakdi last week floated the idea of pursuing a weaker baht to help improve sluggish exports, although central bank Governor Chatu Mongol Sonakul said the interests of exporters had to be balanced against those of debtors.

Taiwan economy heading for stronger growth

TAIPEI, Mar 23: Taiwan's economy is heading for stronger growth, helped by the recent stock rebound and an improved trade performance, a senior official said Tuesday, reports AP

"The worst is over," Finance Minister Paul Chiu said. The economy "is in the process of a recovery" after last year's slowdown.

Better growth is expected in the second half of this year. Chiu said in an interview with Associated Press Television News and Dow Jones

Helped in part by an upturn in the key semiconductor industry, Taiwan's main stock index has gained nearly 30 per cent since Feb 5, when it hit an almost three-year low.

Chiu said the stock rally indicated a government stimulus package announced last month has helped to resume investor confidence.

In addition to lowering interest rates, the government announced tax cuts for commercial banks to help them shore up profits and write off
