## Playing it Cool with Classy Stitches

HALID Mahmud Kahan. one of the directors of Kay-Kraft that is recently having its Eid sale at Alliance Francaise, says about how his company's work rates with those of his rivals - designwise and material-wise, "Pricewise and material-wise, I insist that we are better than the others. As regards the designs, we deal with clothes for both men and women, specialising in "punjabis", "shalwar-kameezes" and "saris". We have ventured into T-shirts too. We have a tremendous variety in our product-line, while our prices suit the pockets of the middleclass very well.

" We work as a team, contributing to the end-product. The team-work involves my wife. Shahnaz, me. Ashraf Manwar Pallob, Hassan, Isharat, Shadheen and others. We pool our ideas together and divide our work, each going into his own speciality. Ashraf who comes from Chittagong Art College contributes a lot towards the aesthetic aspects, having had experience at Arong as well. I have may masters in Management from DU, but have been interested in drawing and painting since my school days. Of course it required a lot of persuasion and time for my family to accept my career in designing. At first I experimented, and when my buyers liked it this gave me the necessary fillip to my career in designing. We have outlets at Sob-

hanbagh and Gulshan." Dwelling about kay-kraft's speciality in "punjabis", Khalid elaborates."We do a lot of experimental work on block prints in 'khaddar' and 'khaddar'type cotton materials which has a more trendy rough edge finishing, in shades of turquoise, blue, green, ash and brown that has a sure appeal. When we began this technique in '93 ash and black were an instant hit, and this was a rarity in the market. Earlier, the middle-classes were contented with white embroidery on white. with a little variation. In '95 we got a first prize from 'Bichitra' for our work. The designs are basically geometrical on the 'punjabis', We've gone in for embroidery too with different stitches and knots. When em-



broidery goes in, the price is naturally higher.

There is a black silk "punjabi" which has geometrical forms plus floral motifs in beige and brown. The patterns have been extended on the chest. This stitch is known as "bhorat" which is like satinstitch. "Kantha" stitch has also been used in some of the "punjabis" as one in which they have used triangles, rectangles and vertical motifs, with the design being carried on to the shoulder, as well as on the sleeves and the wrists. This is done delicately with greys, greygreens, beige and black. The stitches vary and this is done on a self-checked material which is cotton." Our artisans in Jessore and Manikgani specialise in this craft". Kahlid points out.

Another admirable gent's wear is the "punjabi" with 'iri' work on silk which resembles French-knots which is found on the shoulder and front. They present diamond-shaped motifs in white and grey with the knots appearing like flower buds that stand out on the big background stitches. Once again we see varied geometrical formations that delight the eye. The "punjabi" material is a self-striped one.

Yet another "punjabi" with "kantha" stitch has floral motifs which resemble "alpana" designs. There are flowers on the side of the buttons in front, in shades of grey, and extends to the side slits. The patterns continue on to the shoulders. This is done in variations of blue on a beige endi-silk background.

Swirls, curls and diamond patterns are seen in yet another "punjabi" which is a positive sight for sore eyes. There are triangles and squares with the

motifs interlacing each other,

at the side of the garment. The

embroidery stands out well

against the background of black

cotton. This too has been done by the 'kantha- tag". Khalid, asked to elaborate on how his brand of clothes differ from the parallel garment producers in the city, adds, "We have machine work, hand work in 'iri' style in which the needle plays with the thread in an unconventional way. We combine a number of materials with varied type of stitches. We also have a large retinue of workers who are experts in their own fields in the 'mufassil' areas."

The pink chiffon "shalwarkamez" has pink, silver and pale-green floral motif embroidery on the boat-neck, with tiny lines on the waist-line, and the neck. The fashionable halfsleeves too have work on it too. A maroon "shalwar-kamez" has floral motifs combined with geometrical oriental square patterns in black and gold. This too should lure many feminine hearts for the forthcoming festive occasion.

As for Kay-Kraft's selection of "saris", they too were alluring and irresistible, specially the subtle ones with the earthy colours, like the one with the grey-green "paar" and the basic beige background of the main body with its motifs completed with paisley patterns, Aztec geometrical motifs and starbursts in sap-green and red.

## Encounter with Basu Chatterjee

Shoukhin and Rajanigandha famed film-maker Basu Chatterjee was in city recently in connection with the release of his first Bengali movie Hatyat Bristi at Balaka theatre hall. Basu's films are light comedies with sharp focus on the psyche of Indian middle class, their pains and pleasure. Basu spoke to The Baily Star about how he took interest in film, his approach to film and his working method. Excerpts:

Q: How have you taken inter-

est in film? A: Well. I was a political cartoonist for a Bombay-based weekly called 'Blitz' for almost 19 years. Then I came in contact with film society movement. Through film society movement I came to know different kinds of films: Films that are treated as art, films that are treated as language by themselves. There I learned the

beauty of films and was exposed to different films of Italy, Germany, France and Sweden which are denied to audiences in our country. One particular film, 'Bicycle Thieves', jolted us out as it jolted us people the world over. It was one of the first films which was shot entirely outdoors and without established artists and contains no commercial gimmicks. And even it was successful commercially. That inspired us and many others in our country. When Satyajit Ray made 'Pather Pachali', it made me think in terms of making film. Previously we had a feeling that anything good and different and brilliant is being produced in the West. I made my first film in 1970 called 'Sara Aakas', which was a path-breaker in its own way.

Q: Sara Ankas was in Hindi. A: I'm basically a Hindi film-maker. We are Bengalis, living out of Bengal for almost three generations. I had my education in Hindi in UP, Mathura and Agra. I was born in Ajmeer, the holy city of Rajasthan. My father was in Railway and we used to knock around.

Q: Should I call you a filmmaker or director, since you are quite at home with camera, editing, background music, screen play?

A: A film-maker.

9: As a film-maker what is your modus operandi. What I mean to say is how do you con-

ceive a theme and work on it? A: Actually I'm an avid reader. I have a way of thinking. Lots of people have questioned me - why don't you make committed films like Mrinal Sen, Goutam Gosh and others. Well, I think they are within their rights to make the kind of films they are making. I want to capture beautiful moments of life. They may be very few and far between. But that is my way of thinking. And I try to do that only.

Q: But what about serious art film? Don't they portray beautiful moments of life?

A: No. To them it is not the moment of beauty, they just want to portray the stark reality of life, which is also one way of saying things. If one analyses the choice of films I have made one would find out some common factors which are either conflicts between men and women, husband and wife. In Hatyat Bristi you will encounter some beautiful moments and nothing else. A story on how a boy and girl fell in love by writing letters. When they meet the film is over.

Q: Fine, but isn't it only looking at the surface of the things?

A: Well, this is one way of looking. I would like to look like this. Maybe it is surface, but doesn't matter. It's a moment in any case.

Q: How do you select your

A: I select my actors to see the characters. I'm portraying they fit into. I don't do my selection the way commercial films cast their stars, that is they select the stars first then work on the story. Q: But you do work with

It is nothing to do with the way of films I make. But beautiful things are beautiful things. I don't draw any distinction between art and

commerce. Q: You always focus on middle-class in your films.

A: My background is middleclass. Education is the foundation of middle class, reading books was our main enjoyment. In our family it is only I who freaked into films. This is the class I understand, know its pains and pleasure. I made films like 'Rajanigandha' or 'Chooti Chhi Baat' where the hero is seen standing in a queue or riding in a bus. These things were appealing to the viewers that time, mainly because earlier films were very much studio oriented.

Q: Hatyat Bristi is your first Bengali movie. What inspired you to venture into Bengali movie?

A: Well. I'm a Bengali, prabashi Bengali, if you like. I was always asked, why don't you make Bengali films. I said if get an opportunity I will make. And the first opportunity was this Hatyat Bristi, incidentally a co-production, which is an added dimension for my

Q: Do you have further plans to do more Bengali movies?

A: I already have one at hand called 'Chupi Chupi' with the same pair, Ferdous and Prianka of Hatyat Bristi. The shooting is most likely to begin in coming December.

Q: How far have you progressed?

A: The entire script is ready. songs are already been recorded.




