Suicides on alarming rise in dists

An increasing trend of suicide is being observed in different districts recently due to deteriorating socio-economic conditions.

Our Kushtia Correspondent Fakhran Nessa says: Suicides are on rise in the district due to abject poverty and unemployment problem.

A total of seven persons committed suicide here during the month of February, according to police report. On February 1, Rekha Khatun, 17, daughter of Hafez Malitha of village Chakdair committed suicide by taking poison.

An earlier report from Faridpur says: In total 19 suicide incidents took place in several thanas out of eight in the district during the last year.

Three Unnatural Death (UD) cases have been registered with Kotwali police station. Two more cases of suicide have been recorded in Mirpur and Daulatpur police station on February 22 and 23.

On February 26, Rafiqul, 29, son of Samsar of village Vagote in Ramkrishnapur union of Daulatpur thana committed suicide by taking poison.

In Narayanjanj: A young man allegedly committed suicide by hanging himself from the ceiling fan of his house at Sardarpara in Siddirganj thana here on Monday morning.

The man, identified as Abdus Sattar, 30, allegedly committed suicide after returning home from his in-laws house in Mijmij village where he left his wife.

The reason behind the incident could not be known. Police recovered the body

and sent it to the Sadar hospital for autopsy. Another report from Shariatpur adds: A teenage boy allegedly committed suicide at his house at Nagar village in Naria thana on Sunday morning after being failed to wed his fiancée.

Family sources said Kamal Khan, son of Abul Rahman, had an affair with Fatema, a class IX student of the same area. But father of the girl solemnised her marriage elsewhere. After hearing the news, Kamal killed himself.

APB from Madaripur reports: Two housewives allegedly committed suicides in five days in two villages in Rajor thana recently due to family feud, police said.

Shanti Lata Biswas, 25, mother of two children, committed suicide by taking potash at Palita village in Khalia union on February 5. She was the wife of Madhab Biswas.

In the other incident, Ujala Baidya, 16, wife of Nirlat Baidya of South Khalia village committed suicide by taking insecticide.
