Three killers get life team

During his visit to the village, The Daily Star correspondent found some panic stricken people who were available near a tea stall of one Din Ali, in the middle of the village. At first they were reluctant to open the mouth. Later on, on condition of anonimity they told that they were helpless and there was none to look after them.

On March 10 night the outlawed party men kidnapped seven persons including Asadul, Bakul, Shariful, Milon, Modhu, Golam and Moidul with an ultimatum to return them if Taka Seven lakh were paid at once. They also told that if they failed to fulfil it, all the seven kidnapped persons would be

Four out of seven kidnapped persons were released as the first instalment of the total amount was paid, the shocked villagers told this correspondent. The other day three others were also released, but the money was yet to be paid, the frightened villagers told further to this correspondent.

The situation was still grave. It might deteriorate further if the demand of money was not met in full immediately, they told.

After arrest of the outlawed party men and seizure of arms, patrol police came twice in the village. They stopped patrolling the village when the outlawed party activists became more aggressive and vindictive.

A senior member of the village and former member of the union who was mercilessly beaten by the outlawed party men asked this correspondent whether this village was part of Chougacha thana or not as the villagers here had no fundamental rights at all.

The remaining villagers complained to this correspondent that their demand for opening a police camp there after the incident on March 9 went unheeded for reasons unknown to them. The situation might have been checked if their demands were fulfilled. they told this correspondent.

Suicides on alarming rise in dists

An increasing trend of suicide is being observed in different districts recently due to deteriorating socio-economic conditions.

Our Kushtia Correspondent Fakhrun Nessa says : Suicide cases are on rise in the district due to abject poverty and unemployment problem. Family fued, frustration in love affair are also stated to be the causes of suicide.

A total of seven persons committed suicide here during the month of February, according to police report. On February 1, Rekha Khatun, 17, daguther of Hafez Malitha of village Chakdiar committed suicide by taking poision. Three cases of suicide were recorded in Kotwali police station on February 11. Of them two young girls and one boy were the victims, Abul Kalam, 18, son of Abul Hossain of village Harora in the sadar thana committed suicide by hanging himself due to family feud. Sukhi, 15, daughter of Shamsu Malitha of Lahinipara and Doly, 1'3, of village Harekrishnapur in the sadar thana committed suicide by taking poison.

Three Unnatural Death (UD) cases have been registered with Kotwali police station. Two more cases of suicide have been recorded in Mirpur and Daulatpur police station on February 22 and 23. Beauty Khatun, 22, wife of Aman Ali of village Kursha in Mirpur thana committed suicide by taking poison due to family feud.

Daulatpur thana police recovered the body of Shamsul, 22. in hanging condition from village Gorura in Daulatpur thana on February 23. The victim hails from Motmura village of Gangni thana of Meherpur district.

On February 26, Rafiqul, 29, son of Samser of village Vagiote in Ramkrishnapur union of Daulatpur thana committed

suicide by taking poision. In all the cases police sent the bodies to Kushtia General Hospital for autopsy.

Another incident of unnatural death has been reported in Daulatpur police station on February 24.


