## JOB OPPORTUNITY

### NATIONAL PROGRAMME OFFICER

The Royal Danish Embassy, Dhaka invites application for the position of a National Programme Officer for the Agriculture Sector : Aquaculture Sub-Sector. Further the incumbent shall be responsible for daily administration of the local Fellowship Grant Authority and Danida fellowships. The position is available as of 1 June 1999 or before. Qualifications and experience required and broad job description and other requirements are as follows :

#### Position : National Programme Officer

#### Sector : Agriculture ; Sub-Sector : Aquaculture

Qualifications : Post-graduate Degree in Fisheries or other relevant discipline. Should also have a broad experience in other relevant fields such as Rural Development/Agricultural Development. Proven experience in project planning at national and local level and in implementation and monitoring of aquaculture development projects implemented by government agencies and or NGOs. Experience in donor aided development projects and working experience in a donor agency will be an added advantage. Candidate should be able to write reports and to analyse technical reports independently. Proficiency in computer use (Windows, Word Perfect 6.1, Lotus) and knowledge of project analysis/planning tools like Logical framework is essential. Fluency in English, both written and spoken is required.

#### Duties and Responsibility :

1. Programme Planning including preparation of disbursement plan for the sector and identification of new activities.
2. Analysing of Government Planning documents such as Perspective Plan, Five Year Plan/Three Year Rolling Programme and Annual Development Programme relevant to sector/sub-sector.
3. Liaise with Govt. Ministries, Departments, Planning Commission and other relevant institutions and organisations to sector/sub-sector activities.
4. Examine, analyse and comment project progress reports, accounts statements and follow up according to need.
5. Visit, supervise and monitor project field activities on need basis in cooperation with Chief Technical Advisers, Project Directors, Consultants and relevant project staff.
6. Plan and organise missions, e.g. project identification, pre-appraisal, appraisal, review etc.
7. Attend meetings and participate in donor coordination meetings or any other meetings relevant to the sector/sub-sector programme.
8. Routine communication with the Bangladesh desk and the Fellowship desk in the Royal Danish Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
9. Processing of applications for local, regional and Danish fellowships.

The age limit for the above position is 35-45 years. Both male and female qualified candidates are encouraged to apply.
