

Plying of heavy vehicles thru' DU banned

The Dhaka University (DU) authorities yesterday imposed a ban on plying heavy vehicles including truck, bus, minibuses, auto-tempo and the commercial vehicles through variety areas.

The authorities also decided to raise road dividers on the main roads, three-step multiple speed breakers on the 18 different spots and to set up traffic control box on the entrance of every street into the campus.

These decisions were taken

in a meeting which was attended, among others, by the DU Vice Chancellor (VC) Prof A K Azad Chowdhury, Pro-VC Prof. Sahadat Ali, Treasurer M Shamsul Haq, Registrar Muhammad Selim, Proctor AKM Nur-un-Nabi, Dhaka Metropolitan Police Commissioner, DC (South) DC(Traffic), representatives of the Dhaka City Corporation (DCC) and officials of DU engineering section.

The students formed the chain from Teachers and Students Centre (TSC) to the Doel

Chattar on campus for 15 minutes and observed one minute silence and also offered munajat, mourning the tragic death of Riyadha, a student of MBA of the university.

Earlier, the students brought out a silent procession wearing black badge and paraded through the campus while the director and teachers of IBA accompanied them. All the classes held at IBA were suspended yesterday.

NATO airstrikes on Y'slavia must stop: India

NEW DELHI, Mar 25: India today said NATO air strikes against Yugoslavia should be stopped and asserted that such unilateral moves undermined the authority of the United Nations systems, a spokesman of the External Affairs ministry said in a statement.

He said that the air strikes were in "violation of the UN Charter" and also amounted to interfering in internal affairs of a country.

The Indian government urges "that all military actions be brought to a halt, that peace be given a chance and that the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia, a fellow member of the Non-aligned Movement (NAM), allowed to resolve its internal issues internally," the spokesman said.

He said the present crisis in Kosovo can be resolved only through peaceful means and a solution found within the framework of national sovereignty and territorial integrity of Yugoslavia. The government of India also expresses its concern about the possibility of the conflict spreading," the spokesman said.

Meanwhile, Yugoslavia sought India's support in mobilising international opinion against the NATO action. The Yugoslav ambassador to India Colomir Strbac told newsmen here that his country "looks forward to further diplomatic actions besides moral and political support for the firm stand taken by Yugoslav government."

Meanwhile, major political parties in India deplored NATO attacks on Yugoslavia terming them "violations" of the UN charter.
