Sunil Dutt in Ctg

From Staff Correspondent CHITTAGONG, Apr 2: Sunil Dutt, the Indian filmstar-turned-politician, now on a visit to Bangladesh with his team "Hands Across Borders", reached the port city from Dhaka at 8:20 pm today. Hundreds of people including women thronged the premises of Chittagong Circuit House where Dutt is staying, witnesses said. Strict security measures have been taken here with deployment of a large number of police in and around the circuit house. Dutt is expected to leave for Cox's Bazar tomorrow, sources here said.

Khaleque visits tornado-hit areas

PANCHAGARH, Apr 2: State Minister for Relief and Disaster Management Talukder Abdul Khaleque has cautioned that the government would not tolerate any irregularities and mismanagement in distribution of relief materials, reports APB. He said this while visiting different tornado-hit areas in sadar and Tetulia thanas today (Friday). At least 30,000 people of the two thanas were affected by last Friday's tornado. Many dwelling houses were damaged. During his visit, Khaleque distributed relief materials, including rice and sugar, among some 2,500 afflicted families.

CMP arrests 24 on various charges

CHITTAGONG, Apr 2: Chittagong Metropolitan Police (CMP) today rounded up 24 persons on various charges from different parts of the city, a CMP press release said, reports BSS.

CMP has also examined the documents of 58 vehicles at 23 check-posts in the city and detected defective documents of five auto-rickshaws and one motorcycle. Absconders, hijackers, auto-rickshaw drivers and trouble-makers were among the arrested persons.

Journalist dead

Veteran journalist Zahirul Islam died of massive heart attack in the city yesterday. He was 63, reports UNB. Late Islam was the Editor of now-defunct Dhaka Times and Managing Editor of The Daily News. He served as Director, Public Relations, of the Bangladesh Agricultural Development Corporation (BADC). He was a permanent member of the Jatiya Press Club. Zahirul Islam had long been suffering from Parkinson disease. The first namaz-e-janaza of Islam was held at Baitul Mukarram mosque after Magreb prayers. A second namaz-e-janaza was held at the premises of the Jatiya Press Club. The coffin of Islam is being kept at BIRDEM and will be taken to his village home in Matlab, Chandpur for burial today, family sources said.

PM condoles

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina has expressed deep shock at the death of renowned journalist Zahirul Islam. In a message, she said the country lost a veteran journalist through his death. The Prime Minister conveyed her profound sympathy for the members of the bereaved family and prayed for the salvation of the departed soul. In a separate message, State Minister for Information Prof Abu Sayeed said the sudden death of Zahirul Islam caused an irreparable loss in journalism.

He expressed sympathy for the members of the bereaved family and prayed for the salvation of the departed soul. Bangladesh Federal Union of Journalists (BFUJ) and Dhaka Union of Journalists (DUJ) expressed deep shock at the death of journalist Zahirul Islam, former managing editor of the now defunct Daily News.

Khondakar Monirul Alam and Swapan Kumar Saha, president and general secretary respectively of the Press Club placed wreaths on behalf of the club. Meanwhile, Md Abdul Khaleque Bhuiyan and Mirza Tarek, president and general secretary respectively of Bangladesh Public Relations Association condoled the death of Islam, the founder general secretary of the association. In a statement to the press they prayed for the peace of the departed soul.

BSF hands over abducted youth to BDR
