CD Price: Tk 550/-Pandit Bhimsen Joshi is without doubt one of the modern greats of Hindustani music, a vocalist enormously popular with concert audiences for over 50 years. He was born in Gadag (now in the state of Karnataka) on 4th February 1922, well away from the main centres of activity of Hindustani music, and with no family tradition of professional music making, Legend tells of how, determining on a musical quest, he left home in his teens and travelled over much of the subcontinent, learning his art from several masters in musical centres such as Gwalior, Lucknow and Rampur. Bhimsen Joshi is best known as a disciple of the renowned singer Sawai Gandharva Rambhau Kundgolkar, and therefore as a representative of the Kirana gharana made famous by Sawai Gandharva's guru ustad Abdul Karim Khan.



The musical morning begins long before sunrise. The dark hour just before dawn has always been associated with prayer and meditation. In a different context, this hour also witnesses the pain of parting from the beloved. Early morning ragas are therefore sombre and devotional for the most part, while some also carry a feeling of universal sorrow and longing. The first raga of the morning is Lalit. The gravity and pathos of sandhi prakash ragas, or ragas of the time when darkness meets light, emanate from the use of the flattened komal rishabh and the komal dhaivat. The major morning ragas such as Bhairav and Todi also exhibit this feature.
