JCD protests drug business in ZH Hall in DU

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD), student wing of main opposition BNP yesterday protested toll collection, terrorism and drug business (phensidyl) allegedly by some outsider terrorists of the ruling party backed Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) in Zahurul Haq Hall of Dhaka University.
They also demanded immediate arrest and trial of all the terrorists including Tokai Mizan, who allegedly opened gunshots at police in the Zahurul Haq Hall on Thursday.
Condemning the incident, the JCD brought out a procession on the DU campus and held a rally in front of the Vice Chancellor's office at noon.
At the rally JCD leaders said that the outsider terrorists of BCL captured different residential halls of the university by ousting the JCD activists.
Presided over by Monir Hossain, the rally was addressed, among others, by Nasiruddin Ahmed Pintu, Monwar Hossain Rana, Sultan Salauddin Tuku, Mahbulul Haq Nannu, Ansar Ali Khan Joy, Takdir Hossain Swapan and Mostafizul Islam Mamun.

Ershad slates govt for being 'incompetent'

Jatiya Party chairman H M Ershad yesterday slated the Awami League government for being incompetent and inept, resulting in the deterioration of law and order in the country, reports APB.
The deteriorating law and order, he alleged, had given rise to murders, terrorism and anti-social activities. He also held the government responsible for price hike of essentials that is making people's life unbearable.
Ershad was addressing a delegation of Jatiya Mohila Party led by its newly-appointed general secretary Begum Bulbul Nahar who called on the JP chief at his Baridhara office yesterday morning.

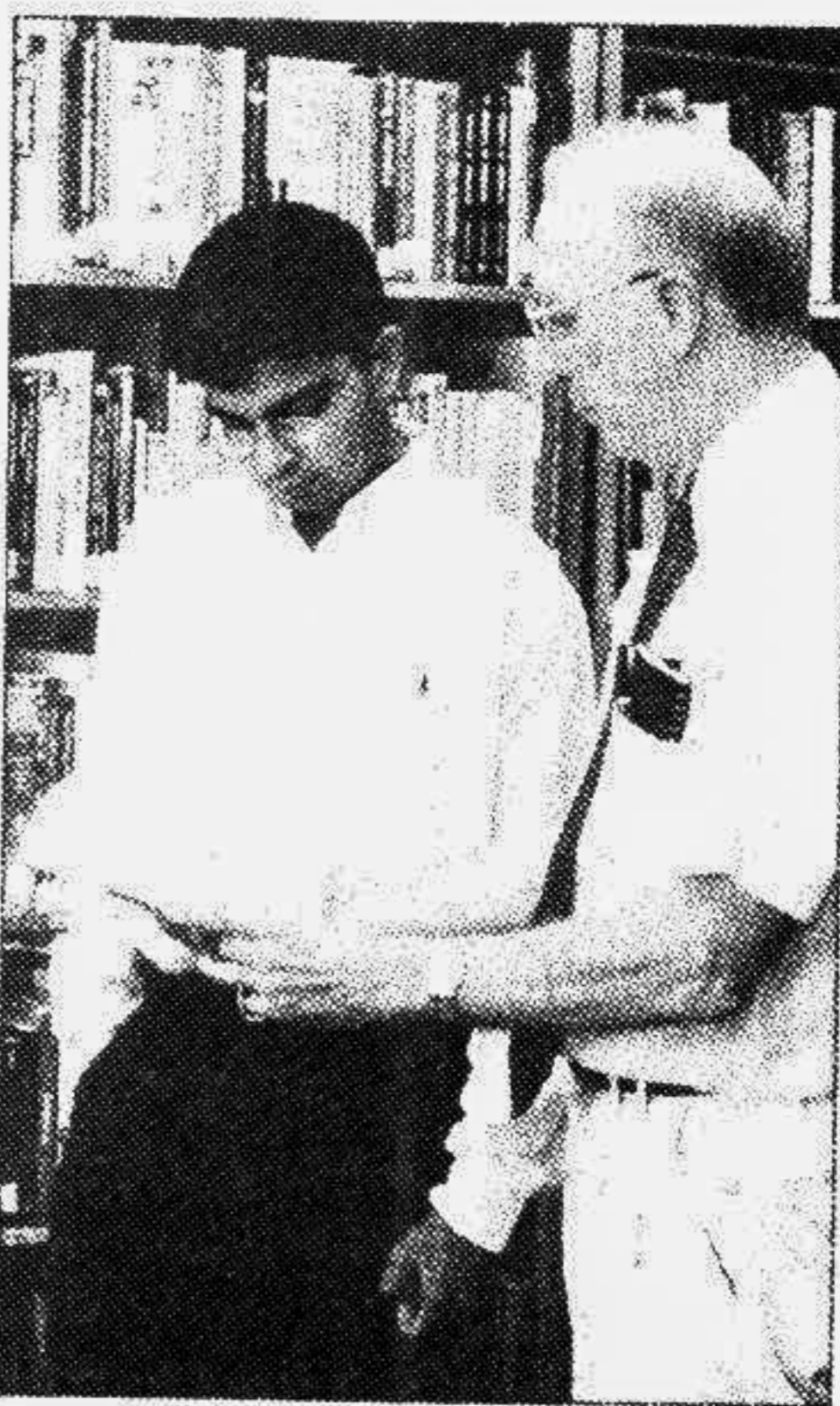
