



## US-aided power plant likely to go into operation by next month

ambassador to Bangladesh John C Holzman sought the cooperation of the Board of Investment (BOI) of Bangladesh for expeditious implementation of the 35 US investment proposals amounting to two billion US dollars, reports BSS.

During a discussion with the BOI executive chairman Sirajuddin Ahmed yesterday, the US ambassador also showed his keen interest regarding the four US invested power generation projects saying that one of the projects — NEPC Consortium Power Ltd — is going into production by next month.

They also reviewed progress of US investment proposals made since July 1996. The progress of three other power generation projects and the proposed container terminals at Chittagong and Dhaka were also discussed during the meeting, a BOI press release said.

BOI chairman raised the issue of US investment proposals on power generation as the country is seriously experiencing the shortage of power and requested the ambassador to play a catalytic role in early implementation of US proposed projects in Bangladesh.

The executive chairman assured the ambassador of all possible cooperation and assistance from BOL


The supporters damaged shops and vehicles and gheraoed the police station demanding release of their leader Jafar Ahmed.


