# Roma Mondol's Solo Presentation

OMA Mondol - not a very familiar name among the music lovers of Dhaka. but it was thought that after her solo presentation at the National Museum, she would have a fan following. Unfortunately for her, the Dhaka crowd did not relate to the singing style of the noted singer. Organized by Shurer Dhara, a local singing institution, the semi-successful soiree had little impact on the audience.

The much-awaited evening by Nadine Murshid

began timely at 6.30. Shurer Dhara sang the opening songs: Shobarey kori aowbhan, Shudha shagoro tirey eshechey noro nari. Aloker ei jhorna dharay and Oder shathey melao, which was well accepted by the audience. Then Roma Mondol began with Bani tobo dhay and Ganer bhetor dive jokhon dekhi bhubon khani.

Roma Mondol's style resembles those heard on DD7, the Indian Bengali channel. She is sophisticated, well groomed and a gentlewoman in every sense of the word but somehow, the audience could not identify with her aesthetic sense. As she sang O amar chader alo, Amar praner manush achey praney and Phirey phirey dak dekhi re, the audience shifter in their seats. A man in the middle of the auditorium was even seen sleeping Of course not all were immune to her enchanting voice, some were engrossed and seemed to be in another world. They were the ones who clapped the loudest and made progam as successful as it is. Had it not been for their presence, the auditorium would have been empty in no time. When asked, a woman in the mid twenties said, "I had expected better from such a celebrated singer. I was really looking forward to this evening, but things are not the way I imagined it to be". An-

other said, "It's the audience who is at fault - we cannot expect everyone to understand or appreciate everything we dish out to them. Roma Mondol's songs are meant for a totally different crowd." I'm not sure what she meant by that or who she was (her reference to 'us' was intriguing) but opinions are opinions. Maybe her opinion too wasn't meant for everyone!

All in all, the solo presentation could not live up to the expectations of the general popu-

lace, but maybe it was because they are not accustomed to Roma's mode of singing than anything else. Congratulations to Shurer Dhara - such endeavors are not only appreciated but welcomed. It is no doubt that the audience will be waiting for them to perform in their own programs, it's just unfortunate that their guest star wasn't much of a crowd-puller. Nevertheless, it was very nice of her to pay us a visit and share with us what she does best.

Kabikantha's 8th Spring Poetry Festival held

In Bengali literature the Spring in all its variations and colour has been treated adorably whether it was in the ancient padabali or in the poems and songs of great Tagore. Spring still never fails to both vitalise and fertilise the imagination of ' the contemporary poets.

Yesterday's Spring (though at the fag end) poetry festival organised by Kabikantha, front-ranking poetry magazine of the country, was a congregation of the poets to share the spirit of the season what the

president of the gathering poet Alauddin Al Azad aptly said "love". Said he, "In this age of decadence only love can save us from a catastrophe. This festival", he continued, "will spark enthusiasm in the hearts of young poets. Poets need informal and unpolitical platform such as this to unite and light the passion for poetry." He also added in his presidential speech that, "As we are standing at the threshold of twenty-first century, it is time to be aware about our history and tradition. Though they may appear closely intertwined, we have to know the fine line between them. "Tradition", he echoed British poet T S Eliot, "is the pastness of the present, not pastness of the past."

The poetically stimulating programme began one hour behind the scheduled 6 in the evening. Thanks to the audience for their patience. May be it was ignored as a poetic licence, a thing in which poets have an inborn right.

This year's festival was a departure from the past. A recitation session was added to the usual poetry reading session by the poets. The recitation section was significant in different aspects, most importantly for the selection of the poets whose works were recited. A rundown: Jibanananda Das, Farrukh Ahmed and Hasan Hafizur Rahman among the dead poets and among the living poets the recitation was from Al Mahmood, Alauddin Al Azad and Fazal Shahabuddin. as Islamic-minded poet, as if anything Islamic is bad and therefore should be discarded. The 8th Spring Poetry Festival yesterday in a way went againstthe grain by incorporating Farrukh in their recitation list. Reciters Dalia Rahman and Aminur Rahman did splendid job to bring out the mood and essence of the poems. In the second session a host of front-raking and up-and-coming poets read their works to the cheering applause of the audience. Of them Al Mujahidi, Mahbub Talukder, Aminur Rahman, Saiful Bari's compositions were

loved by the crowd.

Editor of Kabikantha Fazal Shahabuddin read Jibanananda Das's celebrated poem Tomader jekhane ichcha chole jao and gave an important historical information about the poem that it was first published not in Calcutta but in Kabikantha's inaugural issue in 1956.

Co-edited by Fazal Shahabuddin and Shamsur Rahman Kabikanth set sail into our poetic milieu back in 1956. "We wanted," says Fazal Shahabuddin, who is still keeping the

magazine alive despite rift between the poets and political compartmentalization, "to take a leaf out of Buddhadev Bose and bring out a poetry magazine of the standard set by great Bose himself. That was basically the inspiration to go for a maga-

In explaining how he managed the cash required for the publication Fazal says, "I disposed of any mother's gold ring for 48 takas which covered the major expenses for the paper. We had that spirit of sacrifice in us that time which is a rarity now. This is how the magazine took off the ground."

How the idea of spring festival came in? "Spring, or Bahar in Urdu, has always been a source of inspiration to poets in every cultures and through the ages. Even in Bengal where the presence of spring is so unobtrusive, poets never fail to celebrate the season with their hearts passionately admiring the beauty and grandeur of the season," says Fazal in a pumped up mood.

The festival made its debut in 1980 with all the leading poets participating in it. Till 1986, the festival was an annual poetic event in our cultural firmament. Political bickering. and most importantly rift among poets took a heavy toll on the poetry scene of the country: Poetry festival went into suspended animation. After a long absence of 12 years spring poetry festival made a grand comeback last year at its traditional festival venue at Jhalshaghar, Hotel Purbani with front-ranking Hindi poet Ashoke Vajpayee and celebrated Urdu poet and song-writer Javed Akter as its special


