

Parma, Marseille set up final

The Italians, who beat Atletico 2-1 on the night for a 5-2 aggregate triumph, had their excellent goalkeeper Gianluigi Buffon to thank for several fine

But a goal by Abel Balbo in the first half and another by Enrico Chiesa in the second after Roberto had equalised for Atletico eventually ensured victory and a place in the final at Moscow on May 12.

Leading 3-1 from the first leg in Spain two weeks earlier, Parma seemed to be content to ease through their return meeting but Atletico obviously had other ideas and worked hard for an early strike. That it did not come was due

to a combination of their own poor finishing and the agility of Buffon, who saved well from David Tevenet's header and two well-struck long-range shots by Oscar Mena before Parma woke up in attack. The Italians' opening goal

was worth waiting for and came when Juan Veron broke up an Atletico build-up in midfield, made ground rapidly on the left and then slid a perfect throughball down the inside left channel for Balbo to score with an equally skillful angled shot past the goalkeeper on the run.

The two Argentines continued to combine threateningly but the rest of the Parma team seemed to amble at times and it. was little surprise when Atletico struck back after the

The tall Roberto rose at the near post to head a 64th-minute corner from Oscar Mena past Buffon. It was too late to revive their hopes but it rewarded the Spanish team for their enterprise in fighting so hard to save a lost cause.

Parma, winners of the UEFA Cup in 1995, were stung into a reply and Veron led several attacks, once shooting over from just 15 metres from a fine pass by Balbo, before Chiesa restored their advantage on the night with a well-struck left-foot shot eight minutes from time.

OLIMPIQUE MARSEILLE-BOLOGNA

Captain Laurent Blanc scored an 86th minute penalty to grab Marseille a 1-1 draw at Bologna

The penalty was awarded after Bologna goalkeeper Francesco Antonioli pulled down striker Florian Maurice in the box just as the Italians. seemed destined to reach the first European final in their 90year-history.

The Frenchman, who missed the World Cup final in 1998 after being sent off in the semifinal against Croatia, was forced to take his spot kick twice. But he kept his nerve to fire his shot into the bottom left hand corner of Antonioli's net.

The goal took the 1993 European champions and current French league leaders through 1-1 on aggregate. The first leg in France had ended 0-0.

Bologna took the lead after 18 minutes through captain Michele Paramatti but ended the match in tatters after midfielder Giancarlo Marocchi was sent off in the 88th minute for a crude challenge on Guinea forward Aboubacar Camara.

After the final whistle, the French players taunted the home crowd on their way to the

dressing room prompting Bologna defender Amadeo Mangone to throw a punch at an opponent.

Other players joined in. stewards and riot police ran to intervene and it appeared some Bologna fans vaulted the low railings behind one of the goals to join the fracas.

After about three minutes of chaos in which around 40 people were crowded around the entrance to the players' tunnel, some throwing punches and some acting as peace makers, calm was restored.

Marseille enjoyed the bast of the early exchanges with Robert Pires, Fabrizio Ravanelli and Christian Dugarry hungry in attack and Peter Luccin and former Parma midfielder Daniel Bravo combining fluidly in midfield.

After 11 minutes Dugarry created the first chance of the match, rising above Paramatti to plant a firm header straight into the arms of Antonioli. . But just after the quarter hour Bologna broke down their

right and with virtually their lirst foray won a free kick. Giuseppe Signori swung in the cross and Swedish midfielder Klas Ingesson won the aerial battle with Brazil's Edson

to flick the ball to the back post. Paramatti, totally unmarked, pulled the ball down and lashed it past 'keeper Stephane Porato from a tight angle for his third European

goal of the season. Marseille, still needing just one goal to clinch the tie, pushed forward as Bologna opted to sit back and defend

their lead. Marseille had a golden opportunity to equalise before halftime. Dugarry nonchalantly glanced a header through the heart of the Bologna defence after 40 minutes to put Ravanelli clean through on goal.
