

Thundershowers likely

Rain and thundershowers with temporary *Kalbaishakhi* gusty or squally wind is likely at one or two places over Rajshahi, Dhaka and Sylhet divisions, and the regions of Jessor, Kushtia and Comilla with isolated hails at places during the next 12 hours, reports UNB.

Weather may remain mainly dry with partly cloudy sky elsewhere during the period, the Met Office said, adding that day temperature is likely to remain nearly unchanged across the country.

In its squall warning the Met Office said west or north-westly *Kalbaishakhi* squall speed 60-75 km per hour or more at places is likely to occur over the regions of Pabna, Mymensingh, Bogra, Tangail and Sylhet till 6 pm today.
