Clarification of the report on "Harmful drugs . . on sale in city "

Our attention has been drawn to the similar news items that came out in **The Independent** and **The Muktakantha**, both published by BEXIMCO Media Ltd., on the 4th May 1999, wherein it was reported that a Roche product, *Posicor*, "was being imported to Bangladesh even after its withdrawal by the manufacturer because of their proven harmful effects". The said reports call for the following clarification to avoid any confusion about the real situation:

Posicor, a high-tech cardiovascular drug invented by Roche, was launched in the USA, Europe and many other countries of the world in 1997. *Posicor* was also introduced in Bangladesh in October '97. As a part of the ongoing extensive research programmes of Roche, a 3 year study was also conducted on *Posicor*. The preliminary results revealed that *Posicor* would affect the therapeutic efficacy of a few other drugs if administered as a concomitant therapy. When these findings were communicated to FDA by Roche, the FDA asked Roche to mention these warnings in the label and package inserts of *Posicor* and the approval of the drug was sustained.

Roche, a 103-year-old research based pharmaceutical company, who always considers patients' well being as highest priority, decided to voluntarily withdraw *Posicor* from global market. This was absolutely a voluntary decision and no drug regulatory body in the world had ever asked Roche to withdraw *Posicor* from the market.

It may be mentioned that withdrawing a product from the market by the concerned company is a valid legal process. Many leading national and international pharmaceutical companies have withdrawn their products from the marketplace from time to time due to various reasons.

The decision to withdraw *Posicor* in Bangladesh was taken on 8th June '98 and at the same time necessary steps were taken to remove *Posicor* from different pharmacies. Even not a single pack of *Posicor* was imported in Bangladesh after 8th June '98. The report on *Posicor* being imported after its voluntary withdrawal is as such false and baseless.
